ORDINANCE NO. 2025-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BAUGHMAN TOWNSHIP, OHIO FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Marshallville understand the importance of having fire and emergency response services and;

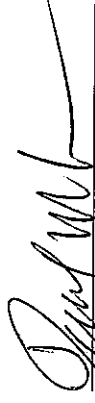
WHEREAS, Council understands that Baughman Township has a duty to provide fire and emergency response services to its residents and;

WHEREAS, Council deems it advisable and responsible to contract with Baughman Township to provide fire and emergency response services to a portion of Baughman Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Baughman Township, Ohio for fire and emergency response services in accordance with the terms set forth in the contract attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A". The effective date of the contract is January 1, 2026.
2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Marshallville and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency is to provide fire and emergency response service uninterrupted to Baughman Township. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
