We hope your family had a wonderful Spring Break! We are excited for school to be back in session! We are quickly approaching the ILEARN testing window which begins April 14. Grade 3-8 students have been working hard to prepare for this assessment, and we want your child's hard work to be reflected in their ILEARN test results. Please ensure your child gets adequate sleep and a good breakfast. Each student is expected to give their best effort.

ILEARN

Our school goal is for each student to be at a Proficient level of At/Above. A school's letter grade is based on the average of points generated by all students in grades 3-8. Students will receive an individual score based on their proficiency level (see below). Students may earn additional points by showing significant growth from the previous year's test, passing IREAD (grade 3), earning a passing score in Science (grades 4, 6), passing Social Studies (grade 5), and/or meeting their English Proficiency Goal (EL students only). Students may also earn points for regular school attendance and academic progress from the previous school year.

Thank you to those who have completed Registration! If you have not completed Registration, please do so as soon as possible. You may schedule an appointment with the school office to assist you with Registration/FACTS. Please remember that completing Registration/FACTS will secure your spot for next school year. Also, if you need tuition assistance, completing the registration process will help ensure Tuition Assistance (first come, first serve).

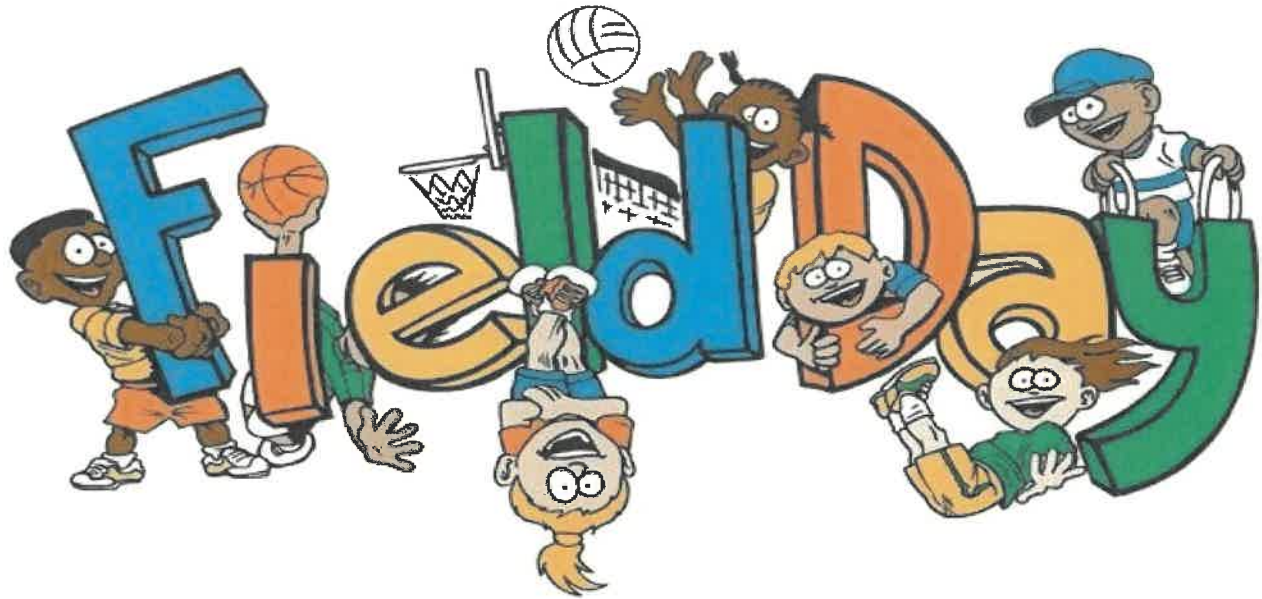


Congratulations to Mrs. Miller's 2nd Grade class for winning the Student Council 'Math Madness'! They correctly answered the most math problems based on their grade level.
