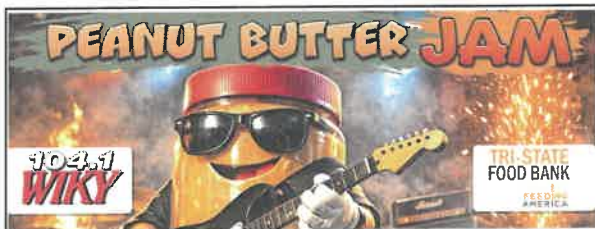
Ms. Scherer's Third Grade class redeemed their prize from the Funfest and had Movie & Pajama Day last week!
