

**City of Kimball Sales Tax
Special Election
June 13, 2023**

Official Results

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City of Kimball, Nebraska continue to impose the one-half percent (1/2%) tax for economic development purposes on the same transactions within the City of Kimball on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, subject to the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

1. Termination of Tax. The City Sales and Use Tax referred to in this Proposition shall automatically terminate at the end of fifteen (15) years from the date on which, by operation of state law, the tax becomes effective, unless the tax is extended by a vote of the electorate prior to the end of such period.

2. Economic Development. During the existence of the City Sales and Use Tax referred to in Proposition No. 1 above, one hundred percent (100%) of the net revenue received by the City of Kimball from such Sales and Use Tax shall be used to fund the City of Kimball Economic Development Program as provided for in the Plan set out in Proposition No. 2.

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall the City of Kimball, Nebraska continue its existing Economic Development Program as described herein by appropriating from local sources of revenue an estimated \$600,000 per fiscal year for fifteen (15) years during the time period for which the City Sales and Use Tax provided for in Proposition No. 1 is in existence?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the City Council of the City of Kimball, Nebraska increase the local sales and use tax rate by an additional one-half of one percent (1/2%) from the current rate of one and one-half percent (1-1/2%) to a total rate of two percent (2%) and impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate only for public infrastructure projects related to municipal roads, streets, sidewalks, wastewater systems, water distribution systems and facilities, transmission lines, water mains and their appurtenances, municipal swimming pool facilities and their operation, airports, buildings and capital equipment used in the operation of municipal government, redevelopment projects, tourism facilities and projects, and equipment necessary for the provision of municipal services, upon the same transactions within the City on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, subject to the terms and conditions set out below?
