



#### ~ Guidelines for Sponsors ~


Any Parishioner of Saint Lawrence who has been asked to act as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism or a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation should contact the Rectory Office for a Sponsor Certificate.

To act as a Sponsor a Catholic must:

- ~ Be at least 16 years of age
- ~ Have received all three sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation)
- ~ If married, be in a valid marriage recognized by the Church
- ~ Attend Mass regularly on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.

In addition, in order to obtain a Sponsor Certificate from Saint Lawrence, you must be an active, registered Parishioner at Saint Lawrence for a period of at least 6 months.

<u>Please note</u>: When requesting a Sponsor Certificate, please contact the Rectory Office at least 2 weeks in advance and allow up to 10 business days for processing.



#### Dear Friends,




The project is funded by free will offerings only. Special envelopes are available in the back of the church for anyone who wishes to participate.


Bishop Frank Caggiano will rededicate the sanctuary on Saturday, December 2nd, at the 5:00 pm Mass.



Men of St. Lawrence, a spiritual battle rages all around us. The nations rage,


inspired by the dragon and his beasts, bringing the rebellion of the fallen angels onto earth. One thing defeats them: the blood of the Lamb.

Safe Environments: Protecting God's Children Awareness Training

All parishioners of Saint Lawrence Parish ages 18+ who wish to volunteer in the Parish must enroll in the Diocesan mandated **Protecting God's Children Awareness Training Program**. You may register online to attend **VIRTUS Protecting God's Children for Adults** by logging on to the website: www.virtus.org and either selecting first-time registrant if this is your first session or by logging in if you have been previously trained. **Please note that if you attended a class more than five years ago, you need to be recertified.** 

Volunteers are also required to attend a live *VIRTUS Protecting God's Children for Adults* class and to return a copy of your training certificate to the parish office.

A criminal background check is also required of all volunteers. Additional information about background checks may be found at www.bridgeportdiocese.com under "Human Resources."

Once you have read the Diocese of Bridgeport Code of Conduct and Sexual Misconduct Policy, the signed acknowledgement should be returned to the parish office.

This is required of ALL volunteers, regardless of whether you are working directly with children.

I confess that I have a soft spot for the scary things Jesus says because they are usually ignored. But there's gold in them thar hills, if we have courage to look. This week Jesus gives us a terrifying warning in his parable about the king who gives a marriage feast for his son and

promptly goes berserk when people don't respond. The point: those who do not properly respond to God's generous invitation will face totally devastating consequences. The invitees who don't show up get their city burned to the ground. The poor homeless man is tortured for not wearing the correct clothes. Scary indeed.

Is Jesus trying to intimidate or bully us into following him? No, because that is certainly not how he treats anyone in the Gospels. A better view is this: to Jesus, your life matters. The universe is not an empty wasteland where anything goes. It is a theater of love offered and either accepted or rejected. How easy it can be to glide through life thinking my life doesn't make a difference. But it does. It really does.

This should not only be sobering but exhilarating. The positive side of the negative in Jesus' scary parables is the thrill and joy that he is inviting us, therefore our lives matter a great deal. There is a reason to get up in the morning. God's generous love is relentlessly calling us. True, obstinately saying no through our indifference is a catastrophe for us and those around us. But how wonderful must the consequences of our 'yes' be?
