

CONSUMING THE EUCHARIST

Dear Parishioners,

It was recently brought to my attention that some visitors may have left with the Eucharist during a busy Sunday Mass. Based on the observations made, the actions indicate ill intent. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Mass. Each consecrated Communion host or fragment thereof, and every drop of the consecrated wine is the body, blood, soul, and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As a reminder, the Eucharist must be consumed in front of the minister of Holy Communion whether it is a priest, deacon or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Do not worry about people behind you. There is no rush. Some communicants may wish to gaze at the crucifix as they receive and so they hop aside to be out of the way. Do not worry about that. You may consume the Eucharist in front of the minister and then even kneel at the communion rail if you wish to gaze into the sanctuary as you finish consuming the host.

Parishioners who are Catholic, have confessed any known mortal sin, and have fasted for an hour (exceptions for those where medication or condition require food) can present themselves for Communion. You can receive in the hand or on the tongue. You may receive standing or kneeling. A gesture of reverence is required, such as a bow or a genuflection. It is most common to receive on the hand while standing, after making a bow at the waist. Face masks should be removed before receiving communion.

The ideal palm position is the left hand over the right hand, palms open, like a throne for the Lord. Make your sign of reverence before extending your hands so your arms do not move while bowing and the minister can precisely place the host onto this throne.

Thank you for helping to protect the Eucharist.
