
Commission signed the Commission Meeting Minutes for March.



Commission met with Mike Teter, Road & Bridge Supervisor, to discuss road conditions and scheduled work.


Commission met with Doyle Cook to discuss County Park issues. There is a problem with birds making a mess outside the Youth Center under the canopy.

Commission met with Megan Edgerton, Juvenile Office, wanting to make some purchases for the DYS Grant with the County credit card.


Commission approved the new lettering on the Expo Center at the County Park to replace the old lettering that has dry rotted and broken. Estimate was \$3891.84.

Commission received reimbursement in the amount of \$1900.00 for CDBG Grant RFF #22 Project 2020-PF-CV05 Water Tower Project.



Commission signed Accounts Payable.



Commission met with Doral Solar to discuss meeting with Mike Teter, Road & Bridge Supervisor, and check on the road use agreement.



Commission signed overtime grant for the Sheriff's office for the "Click It or Ticket" campaign for \$1000.00.


Commission signed invoice for Patriot Technologies for dates of 03/01/26 – 04/20/26 for \$4357.00.



Commission spoke with Travis Elliot, County Attorney, on the phone to discuss assistance and questions on legal issues.



Commission signed Accounts Payable for month of April.


Commission met with Mary Combs, MoDOT. Mary helped the Commission fill out an application and bid packet for our bridge project BRO-R061 (001) creek project.

Commission met with Doral Solar to discuss road agreement, but we still do not have a rough draft from our attorney yet.


