Commission signed Records Disposition.

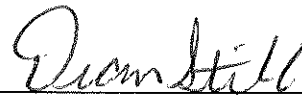
Commission approved the appointment of Tanner Compton & Katlyn Howard as new board members to the Board Of Directors of the Community Development Center (CCDC).

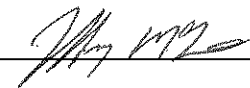

Commission met with Travis Austin, LEPC, to discuss a grant for fire foam that need replaced throughout county fire departments.

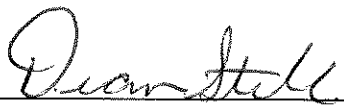
Commission met with Doyle Cook. He was inquiring about a grader position.

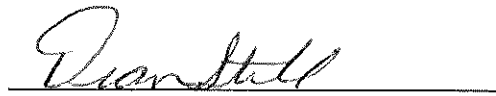
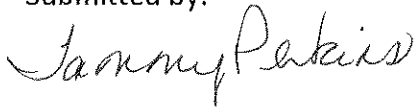
Commission met with Mike Teter, Road & Bridge Supervisor, to discuss road conditions and scheduled work.

Commission discussed leasing tractors for next year and purchasing new brush hogs to do more roadway mowing during the year. Need additional information and firm pricing and leasing terms.

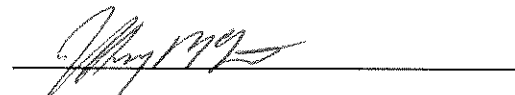

Commission met with Paul, Bill and Cameron, representatives with Ollis, Akers, Arney Insurance, to discuss the county insurance needs.

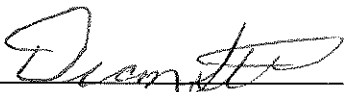

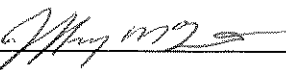
