#### **St John Vianney – Teas and Coffees**

As you know, Archbishop Cushley is joining our Mass on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July and we will be having tea, coffee and cake etc in the hall afterwards. The following Sunday, 30<sup>th</sup> July, we will have the last Baptisms to take place in our buildings, and we will also have teas in the hall afterwards.

To mark our first weekend (6<sup>th</sup> August), sharing the buildings at St Gregory's, we will also have tea, coffee and cake etc after our 9.30 am Mass.

#### **Cluster Walking Group**

Our next walk will be on **Saturday 15 July**. We will follow the **Braid Burn** from Colinton Mains to Cameron Toll, a walk of approximately 4 miles. The walk should take around 1.5 hours. There are one or two short inclines on the walk and lots of exit points along the way for those who would prefer a shorter walk. Those who wish can continue to Portobello, following the Braid and then Figgate burns. This is just under 4 miles and would add around 1.5 hours to the walk.

If you would like to join us, we will take the **400 bus to Colinton Mains** (**0956 at Gilmerton crossroads**). For those wishing to meet us at the start of the walk, the 400 should arrive at the **Colinton Mains Loan bus stop at 1015**.

If you would like to bring a pack lunch, we could enjoy that when we arrive at Cameron Toll (probably in Inch Park).
