Jesus first shows the disciples his hands and his feet, asks them to touch him. Only then does he explain the scriptures and finally send them as witnesses. Perhaps Jesus is offering us a blueprint of how to be missionary disciples? First and foremost, we are the hands, feet and body of Jesus, to bring kindness, compassion and solidarity to others. If they become curious, could we go a step further, gently share what Jesus means to us, and invite them to explore for themselves? Why not invite them to the Alpha Course, run by our very able Team?
