Her service has been invaluable, and I am very grateful for all she continues to give."

The Pontifical Equestrian Order of St Gregory the Great was established by Pope Gregory XVI in 1831. It is one of five categories of papal knighthood of the Holy See, in which recipients are made either knights or dames.
