Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In today's gospel John the Baptist is in prison confronted by doubts. Jesus does not appear to be his idea of a Messiah. Perhaps just as many of us would like, he wanted someone who would sweep into the world and sort things out wholesale. What he is hearing about, is a gentle individual, no wealth, no trappings and seemingly no power. Jesus doesn't rebuke John for his doubts but neither does he directly assert his identity. He sends back word of what he has done. It is in his actions that he reveals he is indeed the Messiah. In today's world it is our actions that show Jesus' message is still alive!
