Leadership Job Description/Expectations

Position: Worship Pastor

Job Description: The Worship Pastor is responsible for the Music Ministry, including planning, leading and supporting those in the music ministry, as well as working with the Pastoral Staff to create a worship experience that honors Christ.

Expectations:

- 1. Meet the 10 basic leadership expectations for all leaders of Tuxedo Church. (provided on next page)
- 2. Communicate with the Pastor and other staff for any details concerning service needs.
- 3. Plan songs for each service that are encouraging and biblically sound.
- 4. Provide support to the worship team by providing set lists, chord charts and listening options and encouraging and praying for each member of the team.
- 5. Oversee scheduling and communication with the worship team.
- 6. Coordinate rehearsals and communicate any details needed.
- 7. Input songs for each service into Proclaim and communicate with the tech booth any additional songs to be placed into the program (altar time).
- 8. Have a willingness to develop and grow those on the worship team both as a group and individually.
- 9. Act as a liaison between those on the worship team and the tech booth for any needs that may arise.
- 10. Be a servant leader and a worshipper by example.

Position: Worship Team

Job Description: The worship team is vital to setting the tone and atmosphere of the church service and leading the congregation into worship, preparing our hearts for God's Word.

Expectations:

- 1. Meet the 10 basic leadership expectations for all leaders of Tuxedo Church. (provided on next page)
- 2. Come prepared for rehearsals and services. At service time, be platform ready.
- 3. Make the Worship Pastor and/or Tech Booth Coordinator aware of any issues or needs.
- 4. Complete any vocal/instrumental warmups before rehearsal time.
- 5. Arrive on time (or early) for rehearsals and communicate to the Worship Pastor if you will be late.
- 6. Be attentive to the Worship Pastor's cues. There may be times when they are being led to go into a softer and more worshipful moment, or there may be times when they feel led to push stronger.
- 7. Your relationship with God is top priority. If you need to participate in prayer time and/or altar time, you have our 100% support.
- 8. Lead expressively, but humbly. This is not a performance, it's a time worshipping our Savior and guiding others to do the same.
- 9. Be faithful and flexible.
- 10. At the end of service, please throw away any paper or trash and make sure any equipment is placed in the appropriate location.
