At M2, our goal is to develop every player to reach their highest potential—while keeping the experience fun, supportive, and family-focused.



M2 Volleyball History

We started in 2021

Our first season started with 11 teams, 140 players and 1 Nationals bid

New Facility in 2022

We moved into our current home in Chamblee with three courts...we have since added a fourth full court and our fitness area.

17-1's Travel to Brazil

In 2024 we started a tradition where our 17-1 teams travel to Brazil to explore the culture and play with local teams. 2026 will be our third year and each time gets even better!

25 Teams have been to nationals

In just five short seasons, we have sent 25 teams, and for the first time this year our 11 National team is also going to Nationals!

We have grown to 43 teams and over 500 Athletes

And we plan to keep growing by adding the best coaches we can find.





Our Coaches

- Are all former players – high school, club, college and/or professional!
- Many have related degrees in Exercise Science, Counseling, or Psychology
- Work closely with our Directors to make sure they understand the M2 philosophy
- Participate in Master Coaching, especially at the regional level, to ensure consistent development.

* Final coaching decisions will be made at the conclusion of tryouts.





Player/Parent Expectations

- You have chosen M2 because you want experts to support your daughter's volleyball journey. There are various ways for parents to get involved productively. Please take advantage of these opportunities and leave the volleyball details to the club.
- By joining M2, regardless of the team's level, you agree to fulfilling that commitment. Each team has a limited number of players, and even one individual lacking the proper commitment can affect the time, effort, and financial investment of the entire team.
- You will read, sign, and follow the M2 Code of Conduct, accepting the outlined consequences. This applies to both players and parents.
- Most importantly, you will contribute positively, whether as a player within your team or as a supportive parent. Negativity is not tolerated at M2.

Expectations by Level

Regional Teams

- Volleyball is an additional extracurricular and your favorite
- Practices and tournaments are mandatory unless previously excused; conflicts are understood
- Season runs through late April to early May

National Teams

- Volleyball is your main extracurricular activity
- All practices and tournaments are mandatory unless officially excused
- Approved exceptions include school trips, family weddings, etc.
- Season continues through AAU Nationals

Elite Teams

- Volleyball is your primary non-school focus
- Attendance at all practices and tournaments is required
- Missing sessions will result in consequences
- Other activities are not valid excuses
- Season extends through USAV or AAU Nationals

Fees and Commitment

Club Fees:

- Includes uniforms as follows:
 - Elite/National: 3x Jerseys, shorts, practice T + Hoodie, Backpack
 - Regional: 2x Jerseys, shorts, practice T + Hoodie, Backpack
- Does not include travel (hotel or airfare) at any level
- Does not include additional training or clinics offered by the club.

Accepting a spot:

- At the end of tryouts, all parents will receive an email with a determination (spot on a team or waitlist)
- You must go into your Playmetrics account and accept the spot.
- Deposits are due at time of commitment as follows:
 - Elite teams – deposits are due at the end of the tryout session
 - National/Regional teams – deposits are due within 24 hours of offer
 - **Deposits are NOT REFUNDABLE.**
 - **Deposits must be made through Playmetrics with either a bank account or credit card. NO EXCEPTIONS**
- At time of commitment, you will be required to sign a financial agreement and select a payment plan.



Fees and Commitment

Financial Commitment:

- Once you commit to a team, you are responsible for payment of all fees for the season, including in the following situations:
 - Injury prevents you daughter from competing for some or all of the season.
 - You willingly leave the team or are asked to leave the team due to code of conduct violations.
 - Financial hardship.
 - *Insurance is an option to assist in these situations.*
- Players who do not meet financial obligations will not be allowed to practice or play with their team until their account is current.
- We offer a discount for players that pay in full by August 1st. We also offer a 5% discount for siblings.
- We only accept Credit Card or ACH payments through Playmetrics (NO EXCEPTIONS)

* Recruiting services are included in our 16, 17, and 15-1 Elite team club fees and are available for our National teams (either as a team or individually) upon request.



How does the tryout process work?

- Register as soon as possible so we can plan!
- Tryouts will be drop off only. We do not have room for observation at the facility.
- We plan to form our elite teams on the first day of tryouts. We will ask players to make a financial commitment at that time to guarantee their spots. ***We will notify parents of players being offered an elite team spot by text prior to the end of tryouts so you can return and help their daughters with the decision!***
- National and regional teams must commit within 24 hours after tryouts. We may also ask some girls to return for call backs if we need more time to observe them.



How does the tryout process work?

- Throughout the process including callbacks, girls will be offered spots on teams, and we will have callbacks and make-up tryouts for younger players and regional teams in the late summer/early fall.
- If your daughter is waitlisted and M2 is her top choice, please be patient as we work through the process.
- 11 and under is 'no cuts.' Tryouts will be used to help place girls on teams.
- We will also start to extend offers to players we have observed during the pre-tryout process.
- September 1st is the official signing day for SRVA. After this day you cannot move clubs without permission. This date is not related to financial commitment which happens at tryouts.



What level is right for my daughter?

Decide upfront how important volleyball is vs. other activities

- How many days/week can you commit to practice?
 - Look at the tournament schedule vs. other priorities (school holidays/spring break are NOT an excuse to miss a tournament)

What can you afford to spend on volleyball?

- Travel expenses include airfare for you and your daughter, sometimes to inconvenient places.
 - Most tournaments require that you stay at tournament hotels (chosen by the club) – while we strive to book moderate options, they may not be the lowest cost option.

Are you willing and able to commit through the end of the season?

- AAU Nationals are not optional
 - If you commit to a National team, you should be prepared to complete the full season

Do your homework before tryouts and don't get caught up in the moment and make a decision you'll regret!



Tryout Conflicts

We have a time conflict with another tryout and may be late.

Arriving late is not a conflict. Just communicate! If you have a tight turnaround between tryouts, just let us know. Arriving a few minutes late will not impact our decisions.

We are out of town for tryouts

- We will be doing pre-tryout observations during our Pre-tryout Clinics
- We will also have additional tryouts for any remaining spots in the late summer/fall
- 12's and under are no cut. If you register for tryouts and then communicate that you plan to play, we will hold a spot.

Another club has tryouts at the same time as you. Can we do pre-tryouts? How do we manage this?

No, Pre-tryouts are only for players that have non-volleyball conflicts (family trip, camp, school trip, etc.)

You should do your research during the pre-tryout period and attend the tryout of the club she is most interested in trying out for. If you do not attend on the first day, there is always the opportunity to come to callbacks for any open spots.



Other Questions

My daughter is new, and we don't know what position she plays! What do we do?

- “Don't know” is a valid answer on the registration form! We understand that especially for younger players, they don't have a position yet

My daughter ONLY wants to play for an Elite team (or regional, etc.), how do we indicate this?

- If you are ONLY interested in a particular level, please let us know at tryouts. Otherwise, we will offer her the highest level she qualifies for.

My daughter is willing to play (or does play) more than one position. Which one does she try out for?

- You can select a primary and secondary position. She should initially tryout at her primary position (and wear that color t-shirt) but should also let the coaches know that she plays an additional position.
