2025 IMPACT REPORT



- Ensured public safety and accessibility on 3.5 miles of recreational public access easements.
- Monitored 132 acres of open space in the Coastal Zone.
- Installed preventative measures for coastal bluff erosion including 96 recycled oyster wattles which repurposed 4,020 pounds of oyster shells.
- Removed approximately 6,500 Algerian sea lavender plants through solarization tarping techniques and hand-pulling.
- Removed 1.8 lbs. of discarded fishing line from Hubbs Coastal Trail.
- Removed 3,560 pounds of trash and invasive species during Lagoona Kahuna Clean Up Challenge.
- Installed 271 native plants along our Coastal Hubbs Trail.
- Hosted (2) part-time fellows in partnership with the Climate Action Corps and CA Conservation Corps.
- Imported approximately 96 tons of rip rap rock, recycled base, and DG to repair sinkhole



- Served 8,526 students through the Academy for Environmental Stewardship school field trips.
- Provided 38 outreach groups with concentrated educational opportunities on Raptor Species, totaling 1,725 people. **AGUA HEDIONDA**
