PAYMENT POLICY

We respectfully request full payment on the day of arrangements for the goods and services we provide for funerals and cremations, unless the funeral arrangements were pre-funded.

We offer a 2% discount on the funeral home's charges (Column A of our contract) if full payment is made by cash or check prior to a funeral.

Payments may also be made by credit card; a 3.25% fee will be added to your contract. Additionally, we will accept an insurance assignment which we file for payment of services. The assignments are processed by a third party for a 4% fee of the total cost of a funeral, or a minimum charge of \$175.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire; and, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase items you did not specifically ask for, we will document the reasons in a statement with a description / itemization of those goods and / or services.

TRADITIONAL FUNERAL SERVICE PACKAGE

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

***\$3165.00 - BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF** - In order to provide exemplary service, we maintain a staff of trained, experienced and appropriately licensed personnel 24 hours a day. Our staff performs many duties termed “professional services,” including, but not limited to:

- the initial contact with the family or responsible parties when a death has occurred
- a conference with the family or its representatives for arranging desired services
- direct supervision of all necessary details for the completion of reasonable requests made by the family
- filing of necessary authorizations and permits
- recording vital statistics for filing of the death certificate
- securing the signature of the certifying physician and filing with the Office of Vital Statistics
- notification of death to the Social Security Administration
- assistance with preparation and placement of obituary notice
- staffing and preparation prior, during and following the use of our facilities for services
- relative overhead expenses such as licensing, insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, administrative costs, equipment and inventory expenses

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *It is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, forwarding or sending human remains.

CARE OF THE DECEASED

***\$1190.00 – EMBALMING** - Embalming is not required by law; it may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements that include a viewing. Embalming is also required for entombment in a mausoleum. If you do not choose embalming, you have the right to select an arrangement that does not require payment for this service (i.e. direct cremation or immediate burial).

***\$350.00 - OTHER CARE & PREPARATION OF THE DECEASED**

This includes refrigeration, bathing, dressing, cosmetizing and casketing of the deceased; as well as any necessary adjustments during the visitation period.

STAFF, EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES & SERVICES

***\$450.00 - FUNERAL CEREMONY** - Coordination of the ceremony (service or Mass); including, but not limited to: scheduling and communication with clergy or presiders, musicians or other participants; directing the order of service; set-up and management of facilities; staff attending to the visitors and service.

***\$240.00 - GRAVESIDE COMMITTAL** - Communication and coordination with cemetery personnel and / or clergy for locations, times, authorizations and requirements; the funeral director’s attendance and supervision on the day of service.

***\$450.00 - VISITATION / VIEWING** - Visitation in a private stateroom; display of floral tributes, sympathy gifts, photos and any other mementos; staff attending to the family, visitors and our facilities; full use of the funeral home’s facilities and amenities, including a dedicated counter space, refrigerator and dining area in our lounge.

***\$150.00 - STATIONERY PACKAGE:**

***\$500.00 - HEARSE AND DRIVER** - Casket coach and driver for transport to a local cemetery
LIMOUSINE AND DRIVER (Seats up to 7 individuals, maximum) - **\$300.00 each**
**Overtime fees for vehicle and driver will apply after 5 hours; the amount will be added to the contract)*

All charges are related to a Traditional Funeral Service; less purchase of a casket & outer burial container, as required by a cemetery.

Includes removal of the deceased from place of death and transport to the funeral home; necessary personnel, vehicle and equipment, securing authorizations; maintaining custodial care, services of staff, and embalming. Excludes shipping charges or staff attendance for visitation and supervision.

\$1980.00 RECEIVING OF DECEASED FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME (graveside burial)

Includes local transportation to the funeral home and casket coach for local travel to a cemetery or cremation facility and return to the funeral home; necessary personnel, vehicle and equipment, securing authorizations and maintaining custodial care. Excludes casket, embalming, visitation, funeral ceremony and cemetery charges.

\$2785.00 IMMEDIATE BURIAL (without ceremony)

You have the right to provide an alternative container for the cremation. The Cremation Authorization Form (CR-1) for the Commonwealth of Kentucky stipulates the following criteria for a container (Section D, page 4, Cremation Rights & Responsibilities):

- be composed of readily combustible materials suitable for cremation
- be able to be closed to provide a complete covering for the human remains
- be resistant to leakage or spillage & rigid enough to support the weight of the declarant or the decedent

The crematory authority may inspect the casket or alternative container, including opening, if necessary. The crematory authority shall not accept for holding a cremation container from which there is evidence of leakage of the body fluids from the human remains in the container.
