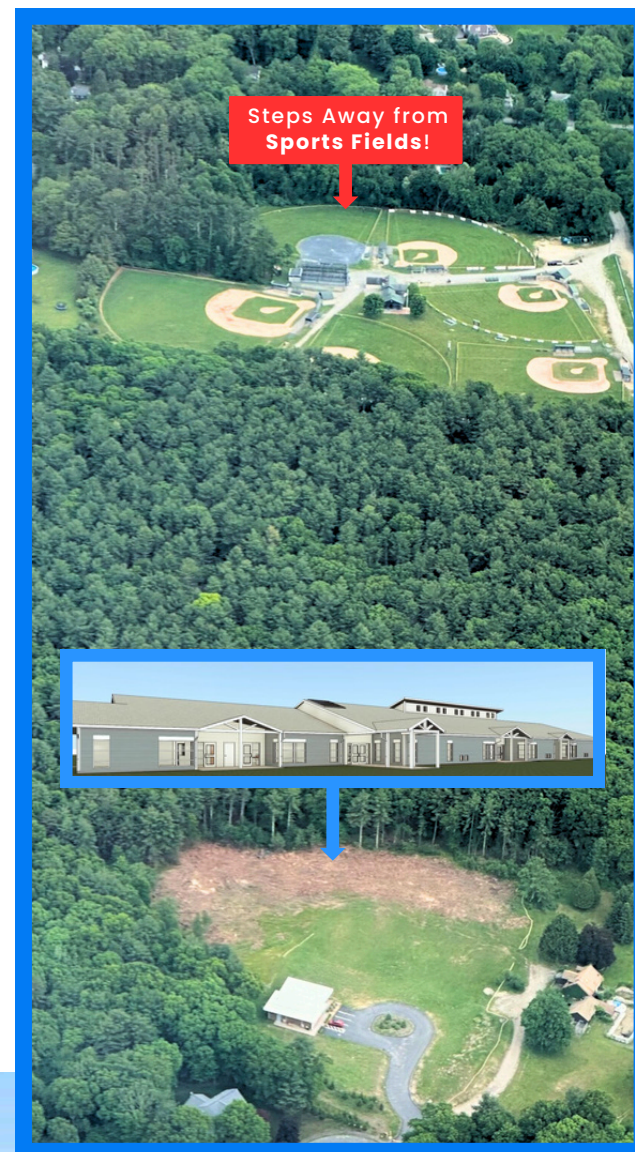




A VISION FOR THE FUTURE
