SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF, AND OVERHEAD

\$ 1,500

This fee represents a proportionate share of our operating costs necessary to provide our customers with the best facilities and services we can offer. It is made up of two components: the services of funeral director and staff and basic overhead.

Our services include: Conducting the arrangement conference; planning service requests; consulting with family, clergy, etc.; obtaining necessary permits and authorizations; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of free or standard obituary notices; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties.

Our overhead includes: (proportionate share of operating costs including but not limited to) Taxes; Licenses; Utilities; Fees; Insurance; Staff salaries.

This fee for our Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff, and Overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements regardless of the package you select.

EMBALMING \$ 925

Embalming is a chemical process that provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Sanitary preparation of the deceased is part of the Embalming process. This procedure must be completed by a funeral professional licensed by the state.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with visitation / viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Service provided is without any attendant rites or ceremonies. Our charge includes Transfer of Remains, Temporary Shelter of Remains, Local Transportation to the cemetery, necessary services of funeral director and staff, and required authorizations. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies, outer burial container, or opening and closing of the grave. Please note that due to no embalming, to protect the public health viewing is limited to family identification.

Please note that due to no embalming; to protect the public health, viewing is limited to family identification. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are:

These Cemeteries require that the Opening and Closing fees be taken care of directly with one of their representatives prior to interment.

CREDIT POLICY: PAYMENT IS EXPECTED WHEN SERVICES ARE RENDERED

It is our purpose to provide quality service and merchandise to those families that we serve and to be fair in conducting all business transactions. The following credit guidelines have been established in order that there be no misunderstandings. If you or your family have a special need or situation, please let us know in advance and we will gladly discuss alternative arrangements.

- 1. Acceptable payment methods are Cash, Check, Money Order, Insurance Assignment, Credit Card, or a combination of these methods. An insurance assignment will be acceptable only upon verification that the insurance policy or policies are in force and must be signed by the listed beneficiary or beneficiaries.
- 2. Any account showing a balance after 30 days from the date of the contract and in which there are no assigned insurance funds pending will be considered past due.
- 3. Each past due account will begin accruing interest on the thirty first (31st) day past the date of the contract. Interest will accrue at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month, eighteen percent (18%) annually, on the unpaid balance.
- 4. Credit Card: There will be a 3.5 % processing fee for using credit card. There is no fee for using a debit card.

Note: If you have a special situation or a financial hardship, please discuss this with the funeral director so that alternative arrangements may be made PRIOR TO THE ARRANGEMENT CONFERENCE. If you wish to avoid interest and/ or know that you cannot make full payment within thirty (30) days, it is recommended that an alternative financing source such as a bank or credit union be considered so that a loan may be obtained, and monthly payments may be made to that Financial Institution.
