- \$1 for \$1 match, up to \$8,500, per Clark County nonprofit
- Eligible nonprofits must be located in Clark County and utilize funds raised in Clark County.

HUDSON-ELLIS FUND \$20,000 MATCH

- 50¢ per \$1 match for Boyle County nonprofits that raise at least \$1,000
- Capped at \$5,000 for each organization
- Matches individual donations from unique donors up to \$1,000
- Match opens Tuesday, November 28 at 9am and lasts until the pool is exhausted

WOODFORD COUNTY COMMUNITY FUND \$3,000 MATCH

Woodford County organizations that raise at least \$500 during the GoodGiving Challenge will receive a \$500 match from the Woodford County Community Fund.

FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY FUND \$1,500 MATCH
