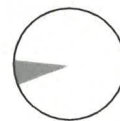

Love One Another Campaign Goal: \$150 MILLION

STRENGTHENING 188 PARISHES:..... \$90 MILLION

Individual parishes will raise funds for their most immediate needs.

SERVING AND HELPING THOSE IN NEED: \$13.5 MILLION

- **Catholic Charities:**.....\$8,000,000
Expanding programs and services and updating facilities to best serve the poor and those most in need.
- **La Sagrada Familia—Our Mission in the Dominican Republic:**.....\$500,000
Increasing access to health care, education, and parish services to 30,000 people in a poverty-stricken country.
- **Catholic Social Responsibility:**.....\$5,000,000
Renewing the Catholic Church's commitment to help urban residents meet their fullest potential.

SUPPORTING OUR PRIESTS, DEACONS, SEMINARIANS, AND LAY MINISTERS: \$13 MILLION

- **Saint Francis de Sales Seminary:**.....\$8,000,000
Providing renovations and updates to the seminary which trains our future priests.
- **Senior Priest Health Care:**\$2,500,000
Securing health care for our senior priests by establishing an endowed fund.
- **Formation and Education:**\$2,500,000
Supporting the need for more permanent deacons and certified lay ministers in parishes by removing some of the financial burden of their formation. Mission-based training for priests to be effective parish leaders.

SUPPORTING CATHOLIC SCHOOLS: \$17 MILLION

- **Catholic Education – Grants to Schools:**.....\$12,000,000
Strengthening our Catholic schools with grants for program improvements, tuition assistance, instructional resources, and updated technology.
- **Seton Catholic Schools:**\$5,000,000
Providing a strong academic education rooted in our Catholic faith to students in urban neighborhoods and beyond.

STRENGTHENING CENTERS OF PRAYER AND MINISTRY: \$16.5 MILLION

- **Parish and School Repair and Replacement Fund:**.....\$3,000,000
Helping parishes and schools with serious financial concerns make urgent repairs.
- **Rural Parishes:**.....\$1,000,000
Providing support to rural parishes facing challenging circumstances as they strive to strengthen ministries and outreach.
- **Mary Mother of the Church Pastoral Center**\$9,500,000
Updating the Pastoral Center to offer increased opportunities for educational training, professional development seminars, and programming to serve all parishes and schools.
- **The Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist:**.....\$1,000,000
Helping to fund a new roof and immediate structural improvements at the "Mother Church" of the Archdiocese.
- **College Campus Ministry**\$2,000,000
Encouraging more than 10,000 Catholic college students to stay connected to their faith.
