Euclid Trash Info:

The City of Euclid is under contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal for weekly collection of refuse and recyclables.

– Place your Kimble trash & recycling cans and bundled refuse on the tree lawn between 6:00 pm the day before your collection and 7:00 am the day of your collection. If your trash is placed on the tree lawn any earlier, you will be in violation of Ordinance #941.05 which includes a fine.

–Collection may take place anytime between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm. Waste containers should not exceed 50 lbs. in weight. Empty waste containers are not permitted to remain in front of any building or residence in excess of twelve hours from the time of collection.

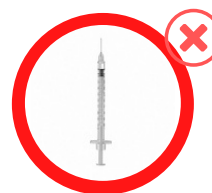
