By working together and staying vigilant, we can keep Euclid clean and preserve the pride we all share in this community.




Preparing for Memorial Day: Honoring Our Heroes with a Clean, Welcoming City

WATER HOLE RESTORATION

Once underground water-line repairs are complete, restoring the roadway above is just as important. A clean, level patch shows residents that we take pride in our work and respect the neighborhoods we serve.

Our crews follow a careful process—backfilling, compacting, cementing, and replacing asphalt—to ensure each repair blends smoothly with the surrounding pavement. This helps the road last longer and keeps travel comfortable and safe.

We are beginning the season by focusing on main corridors, then moving into neighborhood work starting with Section 1. This organized approach reduces disruptions and ensures every area receives the attention it needs.

PERMANENT POTHOLE REPAIRS

As spring arrives and temperatures stabilize, the City shifts from temporary winter patching to long-lasting pothole repairs using hot asphalt. These permanent repairs make a noticeable difference for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians by creating smoother, safer streets throughout Euclid.

As crews move through the city this season, residents will see steady progress on main corridors and neighborhood streets alike — each repair a small but important investment in keeping Euclid moving safely and reliably.

GETTING READY FOR YOUR NEXT STEP

Concrete may not always be noticeable, but it plays a major role in how we move through our community. Public sidewalks, curbs, building entrances, and parking lots all need to stay safe, smooth, and accessible.

Throughout the year, our crews repair cracked or damaged concrete in high-use areas. These improvements help prevent tripping hazards, improve drainage, and keep public spaces looking clean and well maintained. Quality concrete work is more than routine upkeep—it is an investment in the places residents rely on every day.

By investing in high-quality concrete repairs today, we are protecting the spaces families rely on, reducing future hazards, and supporting a cleaner, more connected Euclid.

CRACK SEALING

Crack sealing is one of the most effective ways to protect our streets. Sealing small cracks early prevents water from getting under the pavement, reducing the chance of larger roadway damage later. This keeps our streets smoother, safer, and in better condition for everyone who drives through Euclid.

This season, we will be sealing all excavations completed by both the City of Euclid and Cleveland Water. It is a proactive step that reduces future repair costs and helps neighborhoods stay clean and well maintained.

We also ask drivers to stay alert in work zones. Our crews often work just feet from moving traffic, and paying attention to signs, barrels, and barricades helps ensure every worker gets home safely.

CITY BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS

Regular grass cutting, refreshed landscaping, and consistent litter pickup all play a major role in keeping Euclid looking clean, welcoming, and well cared for.

These efforts go far beyond appearance. Well-maintained corridors improve visibility for drivers, create safer walking routes, and make neighborhoods feel more inviting.

Crews work steadily through the season, trimming overgrown areas, clearing debris, and tending to landscaped sections that help define the character of Euclid.



SIDEWALK CLEAN UP

As warmer weather brings more people outside, keeping our main-corridor sidewalks clean helps Euclid feel welcoming and well cared for. These walkways used daily by residents, students, bus riders, and visitors, and over time they naturally collect dirt and debris.

Regular sidewalk washing brightens these busy areas, reduces slipping hazards, and creates a more pleasant experience for everyone who walks through our community. Clean sidewalks also support nearby businesses by making storefronts more inviting.

This simple maintenance step reflects our pride in Euclid and helps our city look its best for all who live, work, and travel here.



ONGOING SEWER MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT

Please note that the Sewer Department will continue its regular maintenance work throughout the city. This includes servicing catch basins, maintenance holes, and both storm and sanitary sewer systems and street sweeping. Crews will also be camera-inspecting sewer mains and providing support wherever it is needed to keep our infrastructure functioning safely and reliably.

This ongoing work helps prevent flooding, improves system performance, and ensures our neighborhoods remain protected during heavy rain events. We appreciate residents' patience as these essential services continue across the community.
