My dear friends in Christ,

Simon Peter said in reply, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God!”

As we welcome our parents and children back from their two-month vacation, I would like to reflect once again on the importance of our **Sunday Gathering**.

As a child, coming to Mass was one of the highlights of my week. Now, as an adult and as your pastor, I appreciate even more deeply the meaning and beauty of our Sunday celebration. As the Psalmist says: **“Every day I will bless you, and I will praise your name forever and ever.”**
Psalm 145

The Sunday Eucharistic Celebration is the “high point and summit” of our Christian journey. Here, God speaks to us through His Word and feeds us with the Body and Blood of His Son, Jesus Christ. Therefore, we are called to **active, full, and conscious participation—to be on and focused on Christ.**

As we gather, let us remember that our actions reflect our love for God and our respect for one another. As the Lord says: **“Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy.” — Leviticus 19:2**

I kindly ask everyone to help make our celebration prayerful, reverent, and welcoming:

- **Dress appropriately** for Mass and remember that we are coming into the presence of the Lord. Please remove baseball caps before entering the church.
- **Arrive on time** and maintain a quiet, prayerful atmosphere. Please avoid unnecessary conversations during Mass.
- **Turn off cell phones and electronic devices** and refrain from answering calls during Mass.
- **Do not chew gum or eat and drink** during Mass, except when necessary for health reasons.
- **Listen attentively to the Word of God** and be present from the beginning of the celebration.
- **Receive Holy Communion with reverence:** make a slight bow of the head, respond **“Amen”** with faith, and consume the Eucharist immediately. Remain in prayer and thanksgiving after Communion.
- **Participate fully** by singing, responding, and praying the common prayers.
- **Help keep our church clean.** Please leave the pews and surrounding areas clean and treat our church property as **holy ground**.
- **Remain until the final blessing** and until the presider and ministers have processed out.

My dear brothers and sisters, these are not simply rules. **They are expressions of our faith, reverence, and love for God and for one another.** When we gather on Sunday, we are not simply attending an event—we are encountering the living God, receiving His grace, and celebrating our unity as one Body in Christ.

May we embrace these practices with humility and joy. Let us make every Sunday celebration a true expression of our love for Jesus and our commitment to one another.

Hope in Him. Believe in Him. Trust in Him. He is our God who loves us. **He is the same yesterday, today, and forever—the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning, and the End.**

May God bless our families, our children, and our entire parish community.

Strengthening Faith

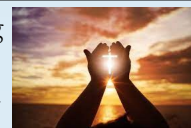
Question:

In Sunday school, the students are studying the Ten Commandments. I know that kids are important in the eyes of God, so I'm just wondering why there isn't a commandment about honoring children.

Answer:

Commandments provide EOO-Equal Opportunity for Observance! They are meant for everyone, children as well as adults. There are several assumptions that would make such a commandment a bit redundant. One, children are entrusted to the care of their parents. So, respect, love, and care — as well as teaching them — are assumed to be part of the responsibility of parents. They are the first teachers in the ways of faith and, as

such, participate in God's work of loving and creating. The child has the obligation and responsibility towards their parents. Only when they are adults will they make decisions on their own.



In Biblical times, and in many societies today, children are responsible for caring for elderly parents, providing for their needs. In our culture today, too often kids have more rights than responsibilities, and oftentimes long before they are able to handle them. If we follow the Commandment of Jesus to love others and treat them as we would want to be treated, everyone is included, children too.

POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

Fortalecimiento de la Fe

Pregunta:

En la escuela dominical, los estudiantes estudian los Diez Mandamientos. Sé que los niños son importantes ante los ojos de Dios, así que me pregunto por qué no existe un mandamiento sobre honrar a los niños.

Respuesta:

¡Los mandamientos proporcionan IOO-Igualdad de Oportunidades para la Observancia! Están pensados para todos, tanto niños como adultos. Hay varias suposiciones que harían que tal mandamiento resultara un poco redundante. Primero, los niños quedan a cargo de sus padres. Por eso, el respeto, el amor y el cuidado — así como enseñarles — se asumen que forman parte de la responsabilidad de los padres. Son los primeros maestros en los caminos de la fe y, como tales, participan en la obra de Dios de amar y crear. El niño tiene la obligación y responsabilidad hacia sus padres. Solo cuando sean adultos tomarán decisiones por sí mismos.

En tiempos bíblicos, y en muchas sociedades actuales, los niños son responsables de cuidar a los padres ancianos y de proveer sus necesidades. En nuestra cultura actual, demasiadas veces los niños tienen más derechos que responsabilidades, y muchas veces mucho antes de poder afrontarlos. Si seguimos el mandamiento de Jesús de amar a los demás y tratarlos como nos gustaría ser tratados, todos estamos incluidos, los niños también.
