**** CLASS for 7th and 8th graders** - This class meets on Wednesdays and ends in May 2026.

The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 24, in the church at 6:45 PM. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in November. This class is for 7th & 8th graders who have never had spiritual formation, who are continuing with their next grade for spiritual formation, or are returning for their first year for communion preparation. Specific information is in our Registration Packets.

**** YOUTH FIRST COMMUNION (2nd year, 7th grade and older)**

- This class meets on Wednesdays and ends in May 2026. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 24, in the church at 6:45 PM. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in November. This is the second year class for 7th to 12th graders who completed their first year in spiritual formation (2024-2025), who would like to prepare for first communion and will commit to attending class in the appropriate class for their grade. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive First Communion in the spring of 2026. Specific information is available from the youth ministry director.

**** YOUTH MINISTRY (1st yr, 9th to 12th grade)**

- This class meets on Mondays and ends in May 2026. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 15, in the church at 6:30 PM. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in November. The St. Joseph Parish Confirmation Program is a two year preparation process. The earliest that a teenager can begin this process is 9th grade. His/her first year is called Youth Ministry. Students who complete the requirements for the first year will be invited in May 2026 to enroll for the second year for the Confirmation class. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive Confirmation in the spring of 2027. Specific information is in our Registration Packets.

**** CONFIRMATION (2nd yr, 10th to 12th grade)**

- The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is Sunday September 14, in the parish school gym at 2:30 PM, with the 5:00 PM Mass to follow. Registration appointments are now completed for students who completed Youth Ministry 2024-2025. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive Confirmation in the spring of 2026. Specific information is in the packets that families received in May 2025.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE **EXPLAINED**

Can We Chew Gum at Mass?

Question:

Does chewing gum break the fast before Communion?

Answer:

If you look in Canon Law or in the Catechism, there is no mention of chewing gum. I guess it does not rate the attention of the universal church! The Church requires us to fast for one hour before we receive the Eucharist. Basically, we are to refrain from food and drink, not including water or medicine. There are also exceptions for people who are ill. Overall, the fast is intended for us to prepare ourselves to receive the Eucharist and in some small way to literally as well as spiritually hunger for what we are about to receive. Chewing gum, while not really food, does at least break the spirit of the fast. Besides that, it is a distraction and rude. What do you

do with the gum when it is time to receive Communion? People have actually come to the altar chewing away, oblivious to what they were doing or Who they were receiving. At best, it is distracting and irreverent. At worst, it adds a barrier to giving our best to receiving God's best.

Pregunta:

¿Masticar chicle rompe el ayuno antes de la Comunión?

Respuesta:

Si buscas en el Derecho Canónico o en el Catecismo, no se menciona la goma de mascar. ¡Supongo que no merece la atención de la iglesia universal! La Iglesia requiere que ayunemos durante una hora antes de recibir la Eucaristía. Básicamente, debemos abstenernos de comer y beber, sin incluir agua ni medicinas. También hay excepciones para las personas enfermas. En general, el ayuno está destinado a que nos preparemos para recibir la Eucaristía y, de alguna manera, para tener hambre literal y espiritual de lo que estamos a punto de recibir. Masticar chicle, aunque no es realmente comida, al menos rompe el espíritu del ayuno. Además de eso, es una distracción y es grosero. ¿Qué se hace con el chicle cuando llega el momento de recibir la Comunión? De hecho, hay gente que ha ido hasta El altar masticando, sin darse cuenta de lo que estaban haciendo o de a Quién estaban recibiendo. En el mejor de los casos, es distractor e irreverente. En el peor de los casos, añade una barrera para dar lo mejor de nosotros mismos y recibir lo mejor de Dios.

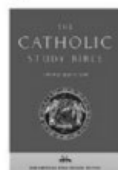

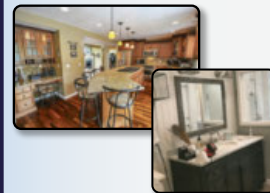

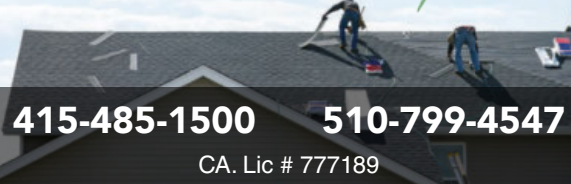
