



### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Salt without flavor is no longer salt. Light that illuminates nothing is no longer light. As Christians, we must be what we have been made to be. So think about it, carefully: what stands between you and being who you were made to be?

### WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

#### **Near-Death Experiences**

##### **Question:**

Are near-death experiences real?

##### **Answer:**

There is a lot of curiosity and fascination with the idea of an afterlife and communicating with those who have died. In movies, television shows, and numerous books, people make claims about their ability to communicate with the dead, or having had a near-death experience. There is no objective way to verify any of this. While details about people and events can be surprisingly accurate, it is just circumstantial evidence that might be explained in other ways. On the other hand, when people have unusual experiences, sometimes called near-death or out-of-body, it is real to them. They react with the emotions and thoughts that one would expect. At

times, they report details they could not have known any other way, such as bits of conversation, or meeting people they had never known in this life. So certainly, to the person, they experience something. We believe in a life after death, we believe in the communion of saints. These things are not a contradiction to faith, but we should not base our faith on them, nor change our beliefs. They are unexplained and will likely remain so.

#### **Experiencias Cercanas a la Muerte**

##### **Pregunta:**

¿Son reales las experiencias cercanas a la muerte?

##### **Respuesta:**

Hay mucha curiosidad y fascinación con la idea de una vida después de la muerte y la comunicación con aquellos que han muerto. En películas, programas de televisión y numerosos libros, las personas hacen afirmaciones sobre su capacidad para comunicarse con los muertos o sobre haber tenido una experiencia cercana a la muerte. No hay una forma objetiva de verificar nada de esto. Si bien los detalles sobre las personas y los eventos pueden ser sorprendentemente precisos, es solo evidencia circunstancial que podría explicarse de otras maneras. Por otro lado, cuando las personas tienen experiencias inusuales, a veces llamadas cercanas a la muerte o extracorpóreas, es real para ellas. Reaccionan con las emociones y pensamientos que uno esperaría. A veces, informan detalles que no podrían haber conocido de otra manera, como fragmentos de conversación o encuentros con personas que nunca habían conocido en esta vida. Así que, ciertamente, a la persona le sucede algo. Creemos en una vida después de la muerte, creemos en la comunión de los santos. Estas cosas no son una contradicción con la fe, pero no debemos basar nuestra fe en ellas, ni cambiar nuestras creencias. Son inexplicables y probablemente lo seguirán siendo.




