My Dear Friends in Christ,

### **HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!**

This Sunday is a very special day as we honor and celebrate all fathers. We thank them for their presence in our lives, for their love, guidance, hard work, and the many sacrifices they have made for their families. No father is perfect, yet they remain a precious gift from God. As Sacred Scripture reminds us: "*Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother*" (Ephesians 6:1-2).

I would like to share with you a story.

At dinner one evening, Tommy misbehaved. His father, always a strict disciplinarian, reprimanded him, saying, "Tommy, if you do not behave, you will be sent to your room!" Tommy did not listen. Ordered to go to his room, he heard his father's final words: "And there will be no more food for you tonight!"

Later, lying in bed, Tommy's thoughts about his behavior began to trouble him. He was hungry. He could not remember ever feeling more alone or alienated. He began to cry.

Then he heard a noise on the stairs. Footsteps came closer and stopped outside his room. The door opened, and his father entered. Closing the door behind him, he sat beside Tommy's bed and said, "I love you, Son, and I have come to spend the night with you."

This story reminds me of my own father. He was a great disciplinarian. He ruled with justice, but always with love. In many ways, he reflected the wisdom found in Scripture: "*Those whom the Lord loves, he disciplines*" (Hebrews 12:6).

My father passed away on October 23, 2016, just four months after I returned here to serve as your pastor. He was the eldest of seven children and was born into a privileged family. A brilliant student, he excelled from grade school through college. He became a journalist and wrote for numerous newspapers and magazines in the Philippines.

Because of his exceptional writing ability, he was invited to serve as speechwriter for the Governor of our province and later became the Governor's Chief of Staff. In public service, he was known as a dedicated, disciplined, and honest man. In a society where corruption and bribery are often common, my father chose integrity. I am deeply proud of him for that.

My father was not an easy man, nor was he an easy father. He could be demanding and difficult at times. Yet he was loving, caring, and self-sacrificing. He loved us in his own way and gave his best to his family. Looking back, I recognize how much of who I am today has been shaped by his example. If I were given the opportunity to choose my father again, I would choose him without hesitation.

Each of us carries our own story about our fathers. Some memories are joyful and comforting; others may be painful and difficult. Fathers can sometimes be challenging, demanding, or imperfect. Yet they can also be strong, generous, wise, and loving. Whatever our experiences may be, today we thank God for the gift of our fathers and entrust them to His loving care.

As we celebrate Father's Day, let us remember the words of the Psalmist: "*As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him*" (Psalm 103:13). May all fathers be blessed with strength, wisdom, patience, and faith as they fulfill their sacred vocation.

Enjoy this special day with your fathers, your families, and your loved ones.

This weekend also we say goodbye to Fr. Salvador! I would like to thank him, on behalf of the community, for his dedicated and joyful ministry here in our community! We will miss him! Personally, I thank him for his friendship and support! As we heard in the first reading today, let us "sing to the Lord and praise the Lord" for all His blessings. THANK YOU, FR. SALVADOR! MUCHAS GRACIAS! Que Dios te bendiga!

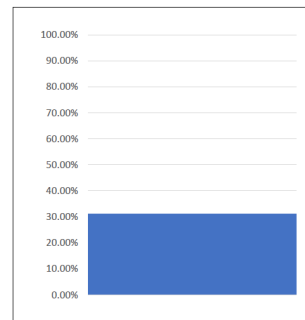

### **LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK**

“What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light.” We all hear God’s voice whispering in our hearts. Discipleship means speaking those words out loud. We all feel the Spirit sing into our souls. Discipleship means that we dance to the tune.

### **WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EX- PLAINED**

#### **Priestly Ordination of Men**

##### **Question:**

Why are only men allowed to be priests or deacons in the Church?

##### **Answer:**

One of the most debated and — in some circles — contentious teachings of the Church is that only men can be ordained as priests and deacons. Critics see it as a way of strengthening a patriarchal system in which women have little or no voice. Those who support this teaching look to New Testament teaching (where we read of Jesus choosing only men to be apostles) and the long-standing practice of the Church. This was certainly the perspective of St. John Paul II who, in his 1994 apostolic letter, *Ordinatio Sacerdotalis*, closed the discussion on the possibility of ordaining women as priests. In the letter, he reflected on the dignity of women and their call to share in the life and mission of the Church, but he concluded by solemnly declaring that “the Church has no authority whatsoever to confer priestly ordination on women and that this judgement is to be definitely held by all the Church’s faithful” (no. 4). This position has been upheld

by Pope Francis in interviews, most notably as he returned from his 2016 visit to Sweden. The ordination of women to the diaconate is another question and one which is being studied. In 2016, Pope Francis created a 12-member commission to study the question from several perspectives (theological, liturgical, historical, etc.). The commission issued an initial report for Pope Francis who later said that the commission had not yet produced a “definite response” to the question because of a lack of agreement on the role of female deacons in the Early Church. For now, however, regardless of what changes might come from ongoing study and debate, the Church continues to reserve ordination to the diaconate to men only, recognizing a vital link between the diaconate and the priesthood and the lack of certainty about the presence and function of female deacons throughout history.

### **POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA**

#### **Ordenación Sacerdotal de Hombres**

##### **Pregunta:**

¿Por qué solo a los hombres se les permite ser sacerdotes o diáconos en la Iglesia?

##### **Respuesta:**

Una de las enseñanzas más debatidas y, en algunos círculos, polémicas de la Iglesia es que solo los hombres pueden ser ordenados como sacerdotes y diáconos. Los críticos lo ven como una forma de fortalecer un sistema patriarcal en el que las mujeres tienen poca o ninguna voz. Aquellos que apoyan esta enseñanza miran a la enseñanza del Nuevo Testamento (donde leemos que Jesús eligió solo a hombres para ser apóstoles) y la práctica histórica de la Iglesia. Esta fue ciertamente la perspectiva de San Juan Pablo II quien, en su carta apostólica de 1994, *Ordinatio Sacerdotalis*, cerró la discusión sobre la posibilidad de ordenar mujeres como sacerdotes. En la carta, reflexionó sobre la dignidad de las mujeres y su llamado a participar en la vida y la misión de la Iglesia, pero concluyó declarando solemnemente que “la Iglesia no tiene autoridad alguna para conferir la ordenación sacerdotal a las mujeres y que este juicio debe ser definitivamente sostenido por todos los fieles de la Iglesia” (n. 4). Esta posición ha sido defendida por el Papa Francisco en entrevistas, sobre todo cuando regresó de su visita a Suecia en 2016. La ordenación de las mujeres al diaconado es otra cuestión que se está estudiando. En 2016, el Papa Francisco creó una comisión de 12 miembros para estudiar la cuestión desde varias perspectivas (teológica, litúrgica, histórica, etc.). La comisión emitió un informe inicial para el Papa Francisco, quien luego dijo que la comisión aún no había producido una “respuesta definitiva” a la pregunta debido a la falta de acuerdo sobre el papel de las mujeres diáconos en la Iglesia primitiva. Por ahora, sin embargo, independientemente de los cambios que puedan surgir del estudio y el debate en curso, la Iglesia continúa reservando la ordenación al diaconado solo a los hombres, reconociendo un vínculo vital entre el diaconado y el sacerdocio y la falta de certeza sobre la presencia y función de las mujeres diáconos a lo largo de la historia.

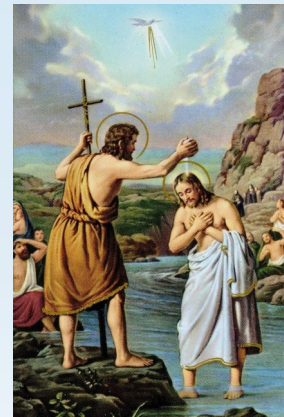

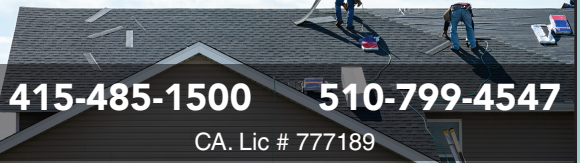
