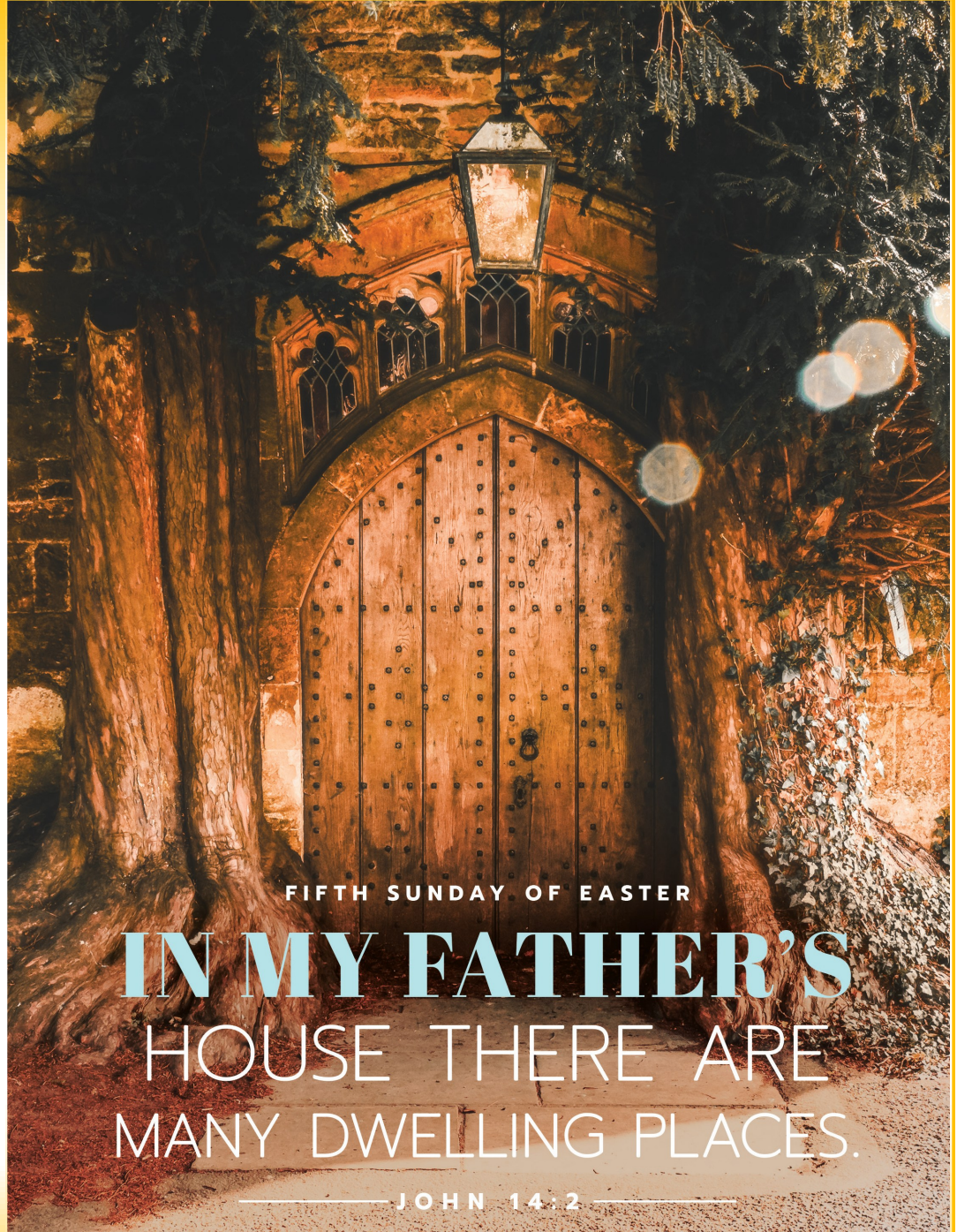

## Reflections



My dear friends in Christ,

We now celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Easter, a season filled with the promise of new life. In today's Gospel, Gospel of John reminds us to trust and have faith in God. Jesus declares, "I am the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:6). He is the One who leads us to the joy, peace, and beauty of the Kingdom. He speaks with the authority of the Father, saying, "Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me" (John 14:11). These words invite us into deeper trust, especially when life feels uncertain.

This coming weekend, we honor our mothers. While they are not perfect, they are a gift from God—entrusted with the care and nurturing of life. Scripture reminds us: "Honor your father and your mother" (Exodus 20:12). We are grateful for their love, dedication, and many sacrifices. We also recognize that they carry their own burdens—struggles, pain, and moments of darkness. Let us continue to pray for them and support them with love.

How, then, do we truly honor our mothers?

First, by showing them respect. "Those who honor their mother are like those who lay up treasure" (Sirach 3:4). Respect invites God's blessing into our homes.

Second, by loving them unconditionally, reflecting the love described in First Letter to the Corinthians: "Love is patient, love is kind" (1 Corinthians 13:4).

Third, by forgiving them compassionately, as we are called to forgive: "Be kind and compassionate... forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you" (Ephesians 4:32).

Fourth, by treating them with kindness and dignity, letting them know they are valued.

Fifth, by remembering them with gratitude—not only in words, but in our time and presence.

As we enjoy this spring season, we are reminded of the new life and hope that come through Christ. In the beginning, through sin, humanity lost the garden and encountered death (Genesis 3). Yet through the Resurrection, Christ restores what was lost. As proclaimed in Book of Revelation: "Behold, I make all things new" (Revelation 21:5). From darkness comes light; from death comes life. Christ is risen—He is truly alive among us.

In our community of faith, we encounter Him in the Word and in His Body and Blood. Because it is truly Christ whom we receive, we are called to approach the Eucharist with reverence and joy. Let us renew our awareness of this sacred gift, never treating it casually, but with hearts prepared and grateful.

Last Sunday, I spoke about the Bishop's Ministries Appeal: One Faith, One Family, One Mission. This theme calls us to unity in Christ. As First Letter to the Corinthians teaches, "We, though many, are one body in Christ" (1 Corinthians 12:12). Together, we are called to proclaim God's Kingdom, making His love visible in the world.

Your generosity over the years has truly reflected the spirit of "God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Corinthians 9:7). I am deeply grateful for your continued support and commitment. As we give, let us do so prayerfully, with reflection and thanksgiving, knowing that every contribution makes a meaningful difference in the lives of many throughout our diocese.

Thank you once again for your faith, generosity, and love.

### WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

#### **Catechetical Sunday**

#### **Question:**

Why do we celebrate Catechetical Sunday?

#### **Answer:**

The mission of the Church reflects the mission of Jesus to teach, preach, heal, and forgive. Through these acts, Jesus shares the good news of salvation and invites all people to share in the life and love of God. The Church continues this mission in all its ministries, but especially, and perhaps most importantly, through catechesis. Catechetical Sunday is celebrated on the third Sunday of September. The task of handing on the Gospel is entrusted to the whole community, who, by word and example, form young and new members in the way of the Gospel. Parish programs assist parents in teaching the basics of faith through liturgical experience, instruction, and faith formation. This ministry is essential for the parish to grow, for individuals to develop as

believers, and for the ongoing spiritual formation of the whole community. It reminds the church that preaching the Gospel and growing in faith are essential to our sacramental practice and our liturgical prayer.
