My dear friends in Christ,

I hope you had a wonderful Labor Day holiday!

On September 11 (Friday), we gathered to remember and honor the nearly 3,000 people who lost their lives in the attacks on our nation 25 years ago. It was one of the darkest moments in our history. Yet, in the midst of tragedy, we also witnessed courage, compassion, unity, and the best of the human spirit.

Why did it happen? It happened because hatred, ignorance, and a disregard for human life were allowed to overcome love and respect.

Twenty-five years later, we must ask ourselves: **Have we truly learned?**

St. Paul reminds us: *"Bear with one another and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord has forgiven you... Christ's peace must reign in your hearts."* Jesus reminds us in the gospel this Sunday that forgiveness has no limit.

Martin Luther King Jr. understood this deeply. Despite suffering hatred and violence himself, he refused to be consumed by revenge. He called people to reconciliation, to forgiveness, and to the belief that every human life has dignity.

My friends, we must recognize that we are all children of God. A person's race, nationality, culture, beliefs, abilities, or differences must never become reasons to hate, humiliate, or hurt one another.

Today, I see too much division and prejudice—people insulted, harassed, rejected, and turned against one another. Families are divided. Friends become enemies. Communities are torn apart.

We cannot allow this to become our way of life.

Reject prejudice. Refuse bigotry. Resist hatred. Resist ignorance and arrogance. Do not remain silent when another person is being dehumanized. Do not empower those who divide us.

The extremists who threaten society are not only somewhere far away. Whenever hatred takes root in our own hearts, homes, neighborhoods, or communities, we too become part of the problem.

Let us honor those who died on September 11 not simply by remembering them, but by living differently. **Let their sacrifice call us to choose love over hatred, forgiveness over revenge, unity over division, and peace over violence.**

As we celebrate the **Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross** on September 14, may the Cross of Christ remind us that love is stronger than hatred, forgiveness stronger than revenge, and life stronger than death.

Let there be peace on earth.

Let there be peace in our hearts.

Let there be peace among us.

Thank you again for being a "cheerful giver!"

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Communion

Question:

Why can't everyone who wants to receive Communion, receive Communion at Mass?

Answer:

Outside of the Church, many organizations have all sorts of requirements for membership: dues, achievements, professional standings, etc. The requirements bring the group together in common purposes and goals. Within the Church, there are also basic "requirements" for receiving the sacraments. As

Catholics, we believe that the Eucharist is the true "Bread of Life." It is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. When we receive the Eucharist,



we are receiving Jesus. Out of reverence for Christ, only those in union with this teaching and in a state of grace should receive communion. As Catholics, we should abstain from communion if we are in mortal sin. While we share many articles of faith with our Protestant brothers and sisters, their understanding of this teaching is fundamentally different. For most non-Catholic churches, they do not believe that Christ becomes truly present in the Eucharist. As such, they should not receive communion in a Catholic Church. These differences are greater for people of non-Christian faiths, and even more apparent for those who do not believe in God. Receiving communion is not a right, but a gift to be accepted in humble, trusting faith.

POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

Comunión

Pregunta:

¿Por qué no pueden recibir la Comunión en la Misa todos los que quieran?

Respuesta:

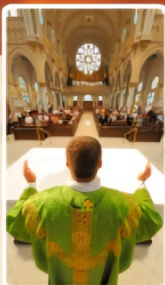
Fuera de la Iglesia, muchas organizaciones tienen todo tipo de requisitos para la membresía: cuotas, logros, posiciones profesionales, etc. Los requisitos unen al grupo en objetivos y metas comunes. Dentro de la Iglesia, también existen "requisitos" básicos para recibir los sacramentos. Como católicos, creemos que la Eucaristía es el verdadero "Pan de Vida". Es el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de Jesucristo. Cuando recibimos la Eucaristía, estamos recibiendo a Jesús. Por reverencia a Cristo, solo aquellos en unión con esta enseñanza y en estado de gracia deberían recibir la comunión. Como católicos, deberíamos abstenernos de la comunión si estamos en pecado mortal.

Aunque compartimos muchos artículos de fe con nuestros hermanos y hermanas protestantes, su comprensión de esta enseñanza es fundamentalmente diferente. La mayoría de las iglesias no católicas, no creen que Cristo se vuelva verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía. Por tanto, no deberían recibir la comunión en una Iglesia Católica. Estas diferencias son mayores para personas de creencias no cristianas, y aún más evidentes para quienes no creen en Dios. Recibir la comunión no es un derecho, sino un don que debe ser aceptado con fe humilde y confiada.

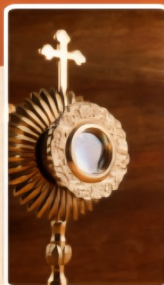
