WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Lateran Basilica

Question:

November 9 is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. What is the significance of this feast?

Answer:

Every diocese has a mother church, the bishop's cathedral, where the diocesan church gathers and celebrates. The cathedral is the seat of the bishop's authority over the diocese. That authority is intended to be one of service to God's people, shepherding and guiding them in a truly pastoral mode.

The pope is first and foremost the Bishop of Rome, as well as the head of the Roman Catholic Church. St. John Lateran is his cathedral, and its prominence derives from that reality. St. John Lateran Cathedral traces its origins to Emperor Constantine, who converted a

portion of the Laterani family palace into a church, and gave it to Pope Sylvester (314–335) as the papal church and residence; St. John refers to the two saints in whose honor the church is dedicated, John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. It became known as the cathedral of the pope, and its facade's inscription refers to it as "the Mother and Head of all Churches, in the City and of the World." The universal celebration of this feast emphasizes unity among Roman Catholics as they unite with the chair of Peter.



POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

Basilica de Letrán

Pregunta:

El 9 de noviembre es la festividad de la Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán en Roma. ¿Cuál es el significado de esta fiesta?

Respuesta:

Cada diócesis tiene una iglesia madre, la catedral del obispo, donde la iglesia diocesana se reúne y celebra. La catedral es la sede de la autoridad del obispo sobre la diócesis. Esa autoridad pretende servir al pueblo de Dios, pastoreándolos y guiándolos en un modo verdaderamente pastoral.

El papa es, ante todo, el obispo de Roma, así como el jefe de la Iglesia Católica Romana. San Juan Letrán es su catedral, y su prominencia deriva de esa realidad. La catedral de San Juan de Letrán remonta sus orígenes al emperador Constantino, quien convirtió una parte del palacio familiar de Laterán en iglesia y la entregó al papa Silvestre (314–335) como iglesia y residencia papal; San Juan se refiere a los dos santos en cuyo honor está dedicada la iglesia, Juan el Bautista y Juan el Evangelista. Pasó a conocerse como la catedral del papa, y la inscripción de su fachada la denomina "la Madre y Cabeza de todas las Iglesias, en la Ciudad y en el Mundo." La celebración universal de esta fiesta enfatiza la unidad entre los católicos romanos mientras se unen con la silla de Pedro.

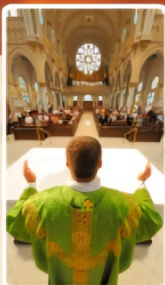

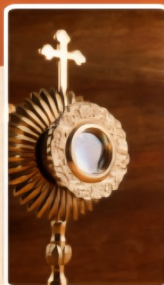
