Reminders to the parents of 2nd year Sacramental Preparation: We are open for registrations now, please register your children early to ensure a seat in class. We have limited classrooms this year. We are offering Faith formation for grades 1-6 and sacramental preparations program. We also offer Bilingual Classes for Sacramental preparations only. Bilingual classes are held every Wednesday from 4:45pm -6:00pm, English classes are held every Wednesday from 6:30pm -7:45pm. We accept cash, check & now, credit cards. Registration fee is \$100. Per child, \$160.00 for 2 kids \$160.00 and \$180. for 3 or more kids

We will begin the year with a Family Mass for all students, parents/guardians on Saturday, September 13, Saturday at 4:30PM. All catechists will be commissioned at the mass. YOUTH MINISTRY & CONFIRMATION

REGISTRATIONS & Start Dates for Grades 7 to 12:

**** 2025-2026 Registrations may CLOSE** when classes begin - For families with returning, continuing or new students rising to grades 7 to high school, our Registration Packets are available at the Parish Center during office hours, on the parish website under "Youth", and at <https://campsite.bio/ymsjcpinole>. For questions, contact Teena Posas, parish Youth Ministry Director, at 510-741-4900 ext. 1010 or by email at tp.sjcpinole@gmail.com.

**** CLASS for 7th and 8th graders** - This class is for rising 7th & 8th graders who have never had spiritual formation, who are continuing with their next grade for spiritual formation, or are returning for their first year for sacrament preparation. This class begins in September, meets on Wednesdays and ends in May 2026. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 24, in the church. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in October. Specific information is in our Registration Packets.

**** YOUTH FIRST COMMUNION (2nd year, 7th grade and older)** - This is the second year class for rising 7th to 12th graders who completed their first year in spiritual formation (2024-2025), who would like to prepare for first communion and will commit to attending class in the appropriate class for their grade. This additional class begins in September, meets on Wednesdays and ends in May 2026. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 24, in the church. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in October. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive First Communion in the spring of 2026. Specific information is available from the youth ministry director.

**** YOUTH MINISTRY (1st yr, 9th to 12th grade)** - The St. Joseph Parish Confirmation Program is a two year preparation process. The earliest that a teenager can begin this process is 9th grade. His/her first year is called Youth Ministry. This class begins in September, meets on Mondays and ends in May 2026. Students who complete the requirements for the first year will be invited in May 2026 to enroll for the second year for the Confirmation class. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive Confirmation in the spring of 2027. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 15, at 6:30 PM in the church. The REQUIREMENT for families to go to second Sunday 5:00 PM Mass each month starts in October. Specific information is in our Registration Packets.

**** CONFIRMATION (2nd yr, 10th to 12th grade)** - Registration appointments are now completed for our second year candidates & their families. Please call if you need to schedule yours. This is the class for teens rising to 10th to 12th grade who completed their first year in Youth Ministry. This class begins in September and meets on Sundays. Students who complete the requirements for the second year may receive Confirmation in the spring of 2026. The MANDATORY first meeting for students and parents in THIS CLASS is September 14, at 2:30 PM in the parish school gym, with 5:00 PM Mass to follow.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Queenship of Mary

Question:

Why do we have a feast for the Queenship of Mary?

Answer:

For many of us, the language of kings and queens may seem like they belong to history or a medieval movie. Royalty have absolute authority over a kingdom and their subjects, a concept that is foreign to many of us today. While Jesus doesn't rule a political kingdom, we honor and recognize him as the King of Kings, Lord of Heaven and Earth. To God alone belongs absolute authority over all of existence.

We may think of queens as the spouse of the king, but there is another key relationship: the king's mother. In

Biblical history, we see instances where the mother of the king is given due as a queen herself, complete with a throne! Mary's guiding influence over her Son is seen most



notably in the Wedding Feast at Cana. Mary is not Queen on her own merit. She is "full of grace" and "blessed" in "all ages" because of the reign of her Son.

¿POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICADA

Reinado de María

Pregunta:

¿Por qué tenemos una fiesta para el Reinado de María?

Respuesta:

Para muchos de nosotros, el lenguaje de los reyes y reinas puede parecer que pertenece a la historia o a una película medieval. La realeza tiene autoridad absoluta sobre un reino y sus súbditos, un concepto que es extraño para muchos de nosotros hoy en día. Aunque Jesús no gobierna un reino político, lo honramos y reconocemos como el Rey de Reyes, Señor del Cielo y la Tierra. Sólo a Dios le pertenece la autoridad absoluta sobre toda la existencia.

Podemos pensar en las reinas como la esposa del rey, pero hay otra relación clave: la madre del rey. En la historia bíblica, vemos casos en los que a la madre del rey se le reconoce como reina, y tiene su propio trono! La influencia guiadora de María sobre su Hijo se ve sobre todo en las Bodas de Caná. María no es reina por mérito propio. Ella está "llena de gracia" y "bendita" entre "todas las generaciones" debido al reinado de su Hijo.

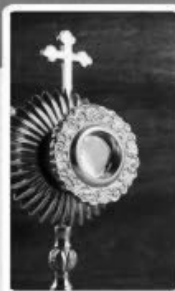

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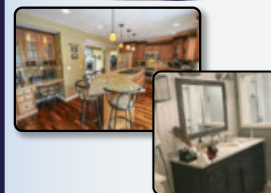
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
