This September, students who audition for the Fall drama production will collaborate in the decision-making process to determine which play to perform. This decision will need to consider the number of students who choose to make the time for rehearsals, including the mandatory rehearsals. Our choices will be between “It’s a Wonderful Life” and ‘Family Man’. Either play will provide us with many opportunities to explore our talents and provide just as many challenges. Once again, we will be embarking on a creative collaboration between students and teachers.

Please understand that we will need just as much dedication to our mission and vision as we all experienced for our last venture, *Willow*. In anticipation of many questions, we have provided the following calendar of events so that planning can begin, and students and parents alike will know whether or not their schedules can accommodate our needs and in some cases, **requirements**.

- ❖ Auditions will be held Wednesday, *September 3* from 3:00-5:30 in the Science room. A list of characters will be posted in the classroom. Remember, you will need to demonstrate your ability to deliver the lines and exhibit personality to the audience! You don’t need to memorize anything for auditions. The character list has been marked indicating which roles require some dialogue work, and those characters which have little dialogue.
- ❖ Play rehearsals will be held **Wednesday and Thursday** of *each week* once again, but those even those characters that have been doubled (two students play those parts) **must be present at least one day during the week** before *major* rehearsals begin. Please note that mandatory rehearsals now include some 3-4:30 rehearsals, 3-5:30 and 3-7:30 rehearsals!
- ❖ Dates will be established for which students **must** have memorized all their lines. Students that cannot meet that deadline will be cut from their part.
- ❖ Please note the mandatory rehearsal times and dates. **THESE ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE! IT JEOPARDIZES THE ENTIRE PRODUCTION WHEN ACTORS ARE NOT AVAILABLE. CHARACTERS DO NOT REACT IN A VACUUM! STUDENTS NEED TO SEE AND HEAR OTHER CHARACTERS TO FEEL COMFORTABLE WITH THEIR PARTS – AND WITH THEIR RESPONSIBILITY TOWARDS EACH OTHER!** *Remember, commitment, responsibility, and sense of community are the real focus of these productions!* To teach this, we need to provide the opportunities to experience this. Please look closely at the calendar and plan accordingly. **Students who cannot meet these requirements for any reason will relinquish their roles.**
