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St. Mary's Academy Announces Policy for Free and Reduced-Price School Meals

Longmeadow, MA – August 26, 2026 – St. Mary's Academy announced its policy for free and reduced-price meals for children served under the **National School Lunch Program** and/or **School Breakfast Program for the 2026-2027 school year**. Students receive one breakfast and one lunch at school each day without paying a fee.

To apply for free or reduced-price meals, households must fill out a **National School Lunch Program Application** and return it to hr@stmarylong.org. Applications are available online at www.stmaryslongmeadow.org or can be picked up at any school office. Only one application is required per household.

Applications may be submitted at any time during the school year. If a household member becomes unemployed or if the household size increases, the family should contact the school to file a new application.
