End of year pupil reports

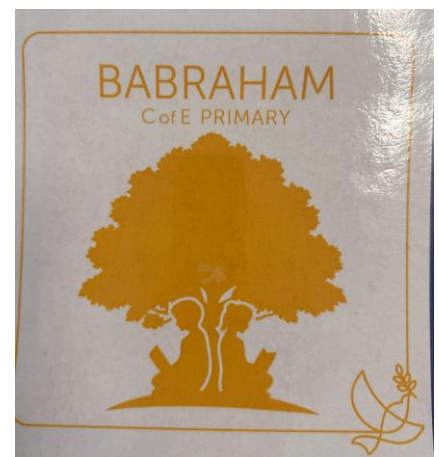

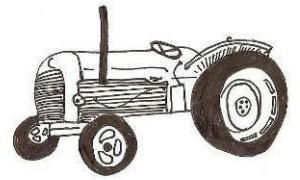
Unfortunately the Government has delayed the release of the Y6 SATs results by one week. Please see the email sent out today by the office, confirming when your child's results will be available.

The children also had fun dressing in battle-wear and looking at the different jobs people did when living and working in a castle. It was a brilliant day and the children demonstrated the school's values wonderfully.



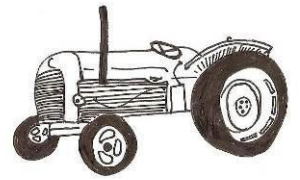

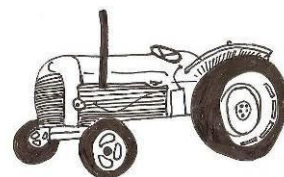
