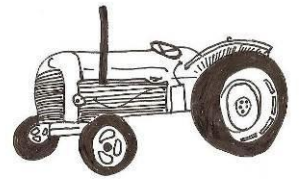
#### **Gardening club**

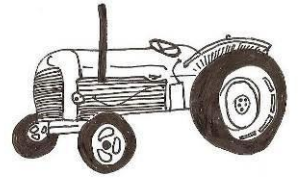
