Open, Adult Amateur, Jr/Yr Divisions

Held during the August 2024 "Summer's End" Dressage Show

2024 Qualifying Season is **May 4th – August 11th**

Eligibility: To be eligible a horse/rider combination needs to accumulate *before* the Summer's End Show:

- **Three** minimum qualifying scores* using **any test** of the same level
- Scores must be from at least **TWO** different WEC dressage shows, **TWO** different judges, from the 2024 qualifying season. Similarly for Freestyles, scores from TWO different judges from TWO WEC different shows.
- Nomination form **Form A** to enter before July 15. Class fee must be included with form.
- Form B is used after July 15, or at the OMT Show to attempt to better a score earned during the qualifying period.
- WEC Schooling shows are not qualifying shows.

The horse/rider combination may compete in only **one** Championship division (Open, AA, Jr/Yr)

- Riders must be declared as "open", "adult amateur" or Jr/Yr on their USDF/USEF memberships
- In accordance to USDF Championship rules, the horse/rider combination may compete at the same level and be eligible for WEC finals if they won last year (USEF DR 127.5).
- Horse/Rider combination can only compete in two consecutive test levels. For freestyle, must declare either USDF or FEI.

Scoring -- Series Placement for USEF-FEI and Freestyle will be determined as follows:

Combined total = 50% of the total of average of the BEST of **two** scores plus
50% of the total score ridden from the designated Summer's End Saturday Class.

Classes: All Championship classes will be run concurrently with the WEC Summer's End Dressage Show.

- You must enter the corresponding Q class Saturday at the Summer's End show. These classes are:

- Test level may be ridden only once for WEC Finals. WEC Classes will be run under USEF Rules, therefore, whips are allowed at all levels and tests may be read. If Tied, Tie will be broken based on the highest average for all of the riders cumulative rides obtained. If still tied is highest collective average from the Summer's End ride.

Championship Awards:

- Qualified riders automatically entered for Door Prize drawing for Opal Pin. Must be present at Ice Cream Social to win.
- USEF – FEI (except Freestyle): By rider division. Championship Neck Ribbons to Grand and Reserve, Series Final ribbons to five places in each level.
- High point award for overall score for the qualifying class score for Jr, AA and Open (not level specific)
- FREESTYLE AWARDS by division (singular placement not by level): USDF: Neck ribbons 1-3, FEI: Neck ribbons all levels.

Award Presentation:

- Rider & Horse must be dressed, tacked and present to receive awards and photo.
- Award schedule times will be posted in the show program. Awards ceremony Saturday late afternoon.
- Championship classes will be awarded percentage and division. Freestyle award not divided by test level.

Entry Details (Use of Form A):

- (1) Form "A" and fee must be submitted by **July 15th** to include the WEC shows, except the OMT Show. Late entries use Form "B".
- (2) See WEC Championship page for class detail, qualifying scores, and awards requirement.
- (3) Fee must be on separate check from WEC show entry fee.
- (4) No nomination fee refunds if not enough Qualifying scores for the WEC Championship.
- (5) Credit cards are US funds only. Credit cards have a \$5.00 processing fee. All fees processed when entry received.
- (6) Choose up to two consecutive test levels.
- (7) One entry for each horse/rider combination.

 - Y Form A notes (2) thru (7) also applicable.
 - Y For a Last Chance score, the you must be PREVIOUSLY have entered, and
 - Y Form B is used for the following (1) you want to replace one of your previously obtained scores, or (2) you have realized you need a qualifying score.
 - Y Form B, as a last chance, is ONLY submitted at the August 22 "WEC" One More Time Dressage Show.
- Please fill out the lower portion of this form and return to the show office with the applicable fees NOT MORE THAN ONE hour after the last ride of the "One More Time" show.

Remember from the 2024 Qualifying Season (see entry information)

- ✓ A submittal of Three minimum scores using any combination of tests of the same level
 - (example: Training, Test 1/Test 2/or Test 3).
- ✓ The Three qualifying scores from any combination, but must be from a minimum of :
 - Two different judges, and
 - From TWO different WEC dressage shows
 - Two different judges in the same show does not allowed.
- ✓ For Freestyles –
 - Two qualifying scores. The average of the score will be used.
 - from TWO different judges from TWO WEC different shows.
- ✓ The average score obtained is used with the Summer's End Competition class Score for your final score.
