

**WHIDBEY EQUESTRIAN CENTER (WEC) 2025 SERIES CHAMPIONSHIPS
OPEN, ADULT AMATEUR, JR/YR DIVISIONS**

**Finals held during the August 2025 "Summer's End" Dressage Show
2025 Qualifying Period: May 3, 2025, to August 10, 2025
DECLARE BY AUGUST 11, 2025**

ELIGIBILITY:

- **4 (four)** qualifying scores* must be earned before August 11, 2025.
(last show to use as a qualifier: Summer Dressage, August 8-10, 2025.)
- Scores must be from at least **3 (three)** different WEC (USEF/USDF Recognized) Shows.
- Scores must be from at least **3 (three)** different judges.
- WEC schooling shows are **NOT** qualifying shows.
- A horse/rider combination may only compete in **ONE** Championship division (Open, AA, JR/YR).
- If a horse/rider combination wins their Championship Class one year, the same combination is still eligible to compete at the same level the next year. However, if they win their level three times in a row, they are no longer eligible to enter Championships at that level (USEF DR127.5), except Grand Prix tests.

ENTRIES:

- Use **Finals Entry Form** for Finals Classes only. See chart below. (Use regular entry form for all other classes.)
- A horse/rider combination can only compete in two consecutive levels (USEF DR 119.2.), including Freestyle levels. Separate finals entry form and fee for each level entered.

SCORING:

Series placings for all levels will be determined as follows:

- 50% of the average total for the BEST THREE QUALIFYING scores; and 50% of the total score in the Summer's End Finals class (Saturday, see chart below).

FINALS CLASSES:

- All Championship classes will be run on Saturday of Summer's End Show. You MUST ENTER these classes (it is **NOT** automatic!!) as follows:
Training – Class 206; First – Class 209; Second – Class 212; Third – Class 215;
Fourth – Class 218; FEI PSG – Class 221; FEI I-1 – Class 222; FEI I-2 – Class 224;
FEI GP – Class 223; USDF Freestyles (1st-4th) – Class 227; FEI Freestyles (I-1/GP) – Class 228.
- Training through Fourth Levels are to be ridden at Test 3 of the level.
- All WEC Championship classes are run under USEF rules: whips are allowed, tests may be read.
- Ties will be broken based on the highest average of **THREE** qualifying scores. If still tied, the highest average of collective marks from Finals class will determine placing.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

- All riders in Finals classes are automatically entered for Door Prize drawing. Rider must be present at Ice Cream Social (Friday evening) to win.
- USEF/FEI Levels (except Freestyles): Series Final neck sashes: Champion through 5th place. Awards ARE divided by levels within the divisions.
- High Point Award: Highest overall score in each division (JR/YR, AA and Open) at any level (except Freestyles).
- Freestyle awards by division (JR/YR, AA, Open): USDF – neck sashes 1st through 5th. FEI – neck sashes all levels/placings. Freestyle awards are NOT divided by test level.

AWARDS PRESENTATIONS:

Rider and horse must be dressed, tacked up and present to receive awards and for photo-op.
Awards time schedule will be posted in the Show Program. Awards ceremony late Saturday afternoon.
