

WHIDBEY EQUESTRIAN CENTER (WEC) - 2026 SERIES CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN, ADULT AMATEUR, JR/YR DIVISIONS

Finals held during the August 2026 "Summer's End" Dressage Show

Eligibility

- 3 (three) qualifying scores* must be earned before August 10, 2026. Last show to use as a qualifier: Summer Dressage, August 7, 8, 9, 2026.
- For the Qualifying Scores
 - Earned score can be any test within the level.
 - Scores must be from at least three different 2026 WEC Dressage Shows. One 2026 PNW show (Lynden, Wa) score may be substituted for a WEC qualifying score.
 - Scores must be from at least three different judges and different dressage shows.
note 1: two scores from two different judges at the same show does not qualify.
note 2: two scores from the same judge at different shows does not qualify.
 - Schooling shows are NOT qualifying shows.
- A horse/rider combination may only compete in ONE Championship division (Open, AA, JR/YR).
- Separate entry for each horse/rider combination.
- If a horse/rider combination wins their Championship Class one year, the same combination is still eligible to compete at the same level the next year. However, if they win their level three times in a row, they are no longer eligible to enter Championships at that level (USEF DR127.5), except Grand Prix tests.

Entries:

- Use Finals Entry Form for Finals Classes only. See chart below. (Use regular show entry form for all other classes.)
- A horse/rider combination can only compete in two consecutive levels (USEF DR 119.2.), including Freestyle levels. Separate finals entry form and fee for each level entered.

Scoring: Series placings for all levels will be determined as follows:

50% of the average total for the BEST three QUALIFYING scores; and 50% of the total score in the Summer's End Finals class.

AWARDS PRESENTATIONS:

Rider and horse must be dressed, tacked up and present to receive awards and for photo-op.
Awards time schedule will be posted in the Show Program. Awards ceremony late Saturday afternoon.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

All riders in Finals classes are automatically entered for Door Prize drawing. Rider must be present at Ice Cream Social (Friday evening) to win.

USEF/FEI Levels (except Freestyles):

Awards ARE divided by levels within the divisions.

Series Final neck sashes: Champion through 5th place.

Champion award: Stitched Leather Halter with series winner's placard.

High Point Award:

Highest overall score in each division (JR/YR, AA and Open) at any level (except Freestyles).

Freestyle:

Awards by rider division (JR/YR, AA, Open). Freestyle awards are NOT divided by test level.

USDF – By Rider Division. Neck sashes, Champion through 5th place.

FEI – By Level, neck sashes all levels/placings.

FINALS CLASSES:

All Championship classes will be run on Saturday of Summer's End Show. You MUST ENTER these classes (it is NOT automatic!!) as follows:

Training 3 – Class 206; First 3 – Class 209; Second 3 – Class 212; Third 3 – Class 215;
Fourth 3 – Class 218. Training through Fourth Levels are to be ridden at Test 3 of the level.

FEI PSG – Class 221; FEI I-1 – Class 222; FEI I-2 – Class 224;

FEI GP – Class 223; USDF Freestyles (1st-4th) – Class 227; FEI Freestyles (I-1/GP) – Class 228.

All WEC Championship classes are run under USEF rules: whips are allowed, tests may be read.

Ties will be broken based on the highest average of THREE qualifying scores. If still tied, the highest average of collective marks from Finals class will determine placing.
