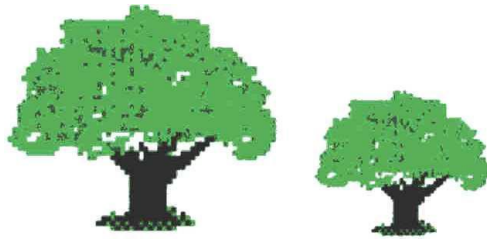


# Green Park Primary and Nursery School

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event outside of normal school hours.

### **Aims and Objectives:**

Our policy for a uniform is based on the belief that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school and it has a positive impact on behaviour and attitudes in school
- Develops a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Identifies children with our school when taking part in out of school educational activities and visits
- Is practical and looks smart
- Makes children feel equal to each other in terms of appearance
- Is designed with health and safety in mind
- Is affordable

Remember to label any clothing. The school cannot accept any responsibility for misplaced clothing but, if the clothing is clearly marked, will make every effort to see lost items are returned.

**There is a set of Green Park uniform that consists of the following items:**

### **BOYS**

Navy blue sweatshirt with school badge

Sky blue polo shirt with school badge (optional)

Short or long grey trousers

Plain grey socks

Black shoes or trainers (must be plain black with no obvious markings or logos)

### **GIRLS**

Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school badge

Sky blue polo shirt with school badge (optional)

Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers (optional blue/white checked gingham dress/playsuit in Summer)

Plain grey/white/navy socks or tights

Black shoes or trainers (must be plain black with no obvious markings or logos)

**PE KIT (Girls and Boys) - To be worn on PE days (no changing in school)**

### **Summer:**

Sky blue t-shirt with school badge

Navy blue shorts

Black pumps (to be kept in school)

### **Winter:**

Sky blue t-shirt with school badge

Navy blue tracksuit with school badge (optional but must be plain with no logos/brands)

Girls may wear plain navy leggings

### **OTHER ITEMS (Optional)**

Book bag - navy blue with school badge

PE bag (for pumps) - navy blue with school badge

Cap - navy blue legionnaire style with school badge

Winter jacket - navy blue with school badge

### **GREEN PARK SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES**

- Please note that only a simple watch is allowed in school - **no smart watches with apps/messaging facilities etc.**
- Jewellery is not permitted for any reason due to health and safety apart from small stud earrings. These **MUST** be removed for PE/Swimming therefore on designated PE/swimming days it is **STRONGLY** recommended that they are removed before coming to school. Teachers are not able to remove children's earrings and as such, if they come to school wearing them, they must be able to remove them themselves. If not, they will be taped up. Ear piercing is therefore recommended to be done in the six weeks holidays so your child does not miss out on PE.
- Nail varnish/make up/transfer tattoos are not permitted.
- Hair longer than shoulder-length (boys or girls) should be tied back at all times with a simple blue/white bobble/scrunchie. Plain hair-bands may be worn but oversized bows/bandanas are not permitted. Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school.

Girls may wear plain navy leggings
