





The average weight of a backhoe construction vehicle (the most commonly used digger at cemeteries) is in excess of 13,000 pounds. Soil conditions and downward compaction over years of pressure from everyday cemetery vehicle use can cause serious damage to unvaulted caskets or caskets placed in simple concrete boxes. In addition, caskets placed into simple unlined concrete boxes are also at risk of severe damage due to moisture and rainfall penetrating through the seams and drain holes.

This occurs because the concrete boxes are only designed to prevent the nearby earth from collapsing. They do not have any proper lining or sealing, thus allowing water and moisture to seep in through the porous exterior of the concrete shell. 


