Etiquette

We encourage self-awareness and respect and the discipline of dance training will aid the development of your child. We therefore enforce uniform requirements and ask you to ensure your child is appropriately groomed to enable them to feel like a dancer and be best prepared to learn and be inspired. All hair must be off the face, girls must have their hair in a bun and only nude, well-fitted dance underwear is permitted. All students are required to change clothing in dressing rooms and/or private cubicles provided – no dressing permitted in foyer areas.

Arrival and departure from studios must be respected. Students should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to scheduled class time to warm-up if necessary and be ready to commence on time. Parents/Carers must collect students promptly at the conclusion of class. Students are not supervised outside of their class times and The Academy takes no responsibility if a parent has not arranged for the collection of their child. Students are advised to not wait outside of the studio premise for this same reason.

Ballet Examinations

These are optional. Classical Ballet Students who choose to participate are provided examination opportunities each year. Students must attend two Ballet Classes per week and Body-Conditioning and/or PBT to be eligible for this experience. The Academy is proud to offer the Royal Academy of Dance examination syllabus from Grade One level and above. Ballet Exams are a fabulous experience for our students who develop and achieve through a positive goal setting collaboration between teachers and student. Exams are provided in our studios in the first few weeks of Term Three and/or early Term Four. Other examination opportunities for older students are available throughout the year and in Melbourne.

Eisteddfods – Performance Team

These are optional. Students wishing to perform as soloists or as part of The Academy's Performance Teams are invited to enquire. These opportunities are available to all students however there is a criteria to be discussed with the Director prior and as per The Academy's Advanced Training Prospectus located on our Website-Members-Page.

Programs

We offer two elite training programs for passionate dance students. Our JET (Junior Extension Training) is designed for students approximately Grade 4-6 and ITP (Intensive Training Program), for students from Year 7. We also offer CUA30120 Certificate III in Dance - Nationally Recognised VET Qualification.

The Academy is also proud to provide the Grampians Region Master Classes (GRMC). These provide additional experiences for not only our students but for the greater community and indeed the region. Please enquire for additional information.

All students are involved in our End of Year Performance and, as this event is the culmination of the dancing year, is a highlight for all involved.

Some years we also have a 'Showcase' Performance in September (not all students involved). Other performance opportunities may become available throughout the year and are advised as they arise.
