# PASTOR'S PAGE

## Points of Reflection

- “When the Chosen People journeyed across the vast desert for forty years (forty indicating a lengthy time of trial), God provided manna to nourish and sustain them. Without it, many would have starved and never made it to the promised land. The manna sent from heaven restored life to their bodies. The Body and Blood that Jesus gives us to eat nourishes and sustains us as we journey through our earthly lives—which can be times of trial—on our way to be with him eternally. Jesus promises us that “whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day” (John 6:54). This is what we celebrate every Sunday and every time we celebrate the Eucharist. The living bread come down from heaven gives us life forever. The true food and true drink we consume gives us true life: life eternal.
- Saint Paul tells the Corinthians that they receive more than sustenance and nourishment when they receive the Eucharist. They also participate in the offer-ing of the Body and Blood of Christ to begin with. This puts us into communion with God and with each other. It also brings us into unity as the single body of Christ, which is the Church.
- Physical hunger is a simple fact of life. Whether we have plenty or live on a limited budget or suffer from malnutrition, we experience the pangs of hunger whenever we have not eaten for a while. Spiritual hunger is a fact of life as well. Our spirits need sustenance and nourishment as much as our bodies do. We need friendship, we need intimacy, we need peace of mind, we need love. Jesus satisfies this hunger and explains it in physical terms. The “true food” he provides is his very self, which gifts us an intimacy beyond any other gift, a communion of love with Christ in the Eucharist.

## Question of the Week

When I receive the Eucharist, I receive Jesus within me. How does knowing that Jesus is in me affect the way I act in the world?

## Infant Baptism

Baptism for children under seven years old will be celebrated on June 20, Saturday, at 10:00 in the morning. Baptism in July will be on July 18, Saturday, at 10:00 in the morning with preparation class for parents and godparents on July 11, Saturday from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. Parents should submit applications no later than the end of June.

## Preparation for Initiation Sacraments

Registration for all classes in Religious Education is going on with deadline set for July 5. We have to order books and educational materials on July 7<sup>th</sup>. Parents: registration after July 5 is subject to additional fee as we would have to order additional materials. Please know or be reminded that shipping charges to Hawaii from the mainland are high. Which class to register for:

- ◆ For adults 18 years old and above who need Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist or First Holy Communion. Classes will start on July 1<sup>st</sup>, Wednesday, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and every Wednesday thereafter. Applications are due on June 14. If you have already picked up a form (Diocese of Honolulu Adult Initiation Inventory), please bring it back either to the Information Table after any Mass or to the parish office, Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please note that the parish office is closed on holidays and weekends.
- ◆ First Grade to High School: classes will start on August 9, Sunday, from 12:30 p.m. to 1:45 p.m. and every Sunday thereafter. Registration forms are due no later than July 5. There will be additional fee for late registration. Baptism certificates are required for those who were baptized and birth certificate for the unbaptized. Pick up registration forms after any Mass on weekends or come to the parish office Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

# MEMORANDUM

**TO: All the Faithful**

**FROM:** Rev. Alfred Omar B. Guerrero, Director of the Office of Worship, Diocese of Honolulu

**DATE:** May 25, 2026

**RE: Plenary Indulgences for Special Jubilee Year of St. Francis in the Diocese of Honolulu**

On the occasion of the Year of Saint Francis, which runs until January 2027, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father), also applicable in the form of suffrage for the souls in Purgatory:

1) to members:

- of the Franciscan Families of the First, Second and Third Orders Regular and Secular;
- of Institutes of Consecrated Life, Societies of Apostolic Life and public or private associations of the faithful, male and female, who observe the Rule of Saint Francis or are inspired by his spirituality or perpetuate his charism in any form;

2) to all the faithful without distinction

who, **with a heart detached from sin, participate in the Year of Saint Francis by visiting, in the form of a pilgrimage, any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship anywhere in the world dedicated to Saint Francis or connected to him for any reason**, and there devoutly follow the Jubilee rites or spend at least a reasonable period of time in pious meditation and raise prayers to God so that, following the example of Saint Francis, feelings of Christian charity towards their neighbors and authentic vows of harmony and peace among peoples may spring forth in their hearts, concluding with the Our Father, the Creed and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Clare and all the Saints of the Franciscan Family.

The elderly, the sick and those who take care of them, and all those who are unable to leave their homes for serious reasons may also obtain a Plenary Indulgence, provided they detach themselves from any sin and intend to fulfil the three usual conditions as soon as possible, if they unite themselves spiritually to the jubilee celebrations of the Year of Saint Francis, offering to the Merciful God their prayers, the pains or sufferings of their lives.

**The designated pilgrimage sites by Bishop Larry Silva in the Diocese of Honolulu are: Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa (Honolulu), St. Francis Church (Kalaupapa), Holy Trinity Church (Kuliouou), St. Rita Church (Nanakuli), Immaculate Conception Church (Lihue), Christ the King Church (Kahului), St. Damien Church (Kaunakakai), Sacred Hearts (Lanai), St. Michael the Archangel Church (Kailua-Kona), and St. Joseph Church (Hilo).**

# MASTER PLAN UPDATE

As the Diocese continues the financial system conversions there are the gradual report updates received by the Parish. Progress continues albeit with several rain event interruptions. We are currently preparing for 5 separate Slab on Grade (SOG) Pours with control joints/saw cuts to prevent the floors from cracking. Concrete will then be ground & polished to show some of the aggregate. The Sanctuary, Baptismal Font, and possibly the center aisle will have a Mapei floor coating applied over the concrete.

Glu Lam Beam sanding & staining has commenced with roof sheathing, roofing and fireproofing to follow. Simultaneously fire sprinklers, HVAC ducting & RTU AC curbs are being installed. This will be followed by the rough-in of lighting, audio visual speakers, and cameras.

This will be followed by DensGlass/Flashings around the metal stud light gauge framing for the windows and the completions of the data com, electrical, and unisex restrooms. Pews, celebrant chairs, prie dieu, podium, and ambray is scheduled to arrive and installed in the July-August time frame. Interior work will take place over the next few months following that.
