RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Last week Sunday (October 26th) the Religious Education students along with their parents had the opportunity to participate in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament led by Fr. Preston. This was a time for everyone to pray in silence and bring their personal intentions and petitions to Jesus who is physically present before them in the monstrance. Father Preston explained what adoration is, what to do in adoration, and what liturgical items are used for adoration such as the luna (the circular vessel that holds the Eucharist) and monstrance (sacred vessel that holds the luna for the people to look, adore and pray to Jesus who is contained in the Eucharist). Our Lady of Perpetual Help has weekly Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Wednesdays from 5PM-6PM in the Church with silence and Vespers (Evening Prayer) for those who want to strengthen their relationship with Jesus and needs silence.

 - Honors the history and mission of Catholicism in Hawai'i
- Originality & Creativity**
 - Original work created by the entrant (no AI-generated or copied artwork)
 - Artistic expression is encouraged
- Simplicity & Versatility**
 - Clean and scalable for various uses (digital, print, shirts, etc.)
 - Looks good in both **color and black & white**
- Incorporation of Elements (Optional but encouraged)**
 - Catholic symbols (e.g., cross, Bible, Holy Spirit, rosary, church architecture)
 - Hawaiian cultural symbols (e.g., plumeria, taro leaf, canoe, islands, ocean, lei)
- Technical Specifications**
 - Format: JPEG or PNG (high resolution, at least 300 DPI)
 - If chosen as a finalist, the original editable design file may be requested (e.g., PSD, AI, or vector format)

ART GUIDELINES:

- Logo reflects Mission of Aloha, Catholic faith, and Hawaiian Culture
- Original art, creative, and versatile
- Effective in black and white
- Submit as a JPEG or PNG (300 DPI)
- No AI-generated or copied art
- No Lettering - your art carries the message
- Submissions at the Diocesan Level will be scored on application and interpretation of the theme, neatness, presentation, creativity and effort.

GENERAL RULES:

- Contestants may enter only once. Entries not conforming to the rules will be disqualified.
- All contest submissions becomes the property of the Diocese of Honolulu and Hawaii Catholic School Department with the right to display/and or publish any or all material.
- Decisions of the judges will be final. Judges reserve the right to make no award in a Division.
- Each entry sent to the diocesan level, must be accompanied by a 2025 Entry Form properly signed and completed. Names must be legible. Forms must be taped to back of entry.
- Plagiarism is grounds for disqualification from contest. Commercial entries will be disqualified.
- Awards will be provided to Diocesan 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each of four levels (K-2, 3-5; 6-8; 9-12)
- Parish/Schools will conduct their own local contest and forward their top winner in each division to the Hawaii Catholic Schools Office
 - Parish/Schools are encouraged to celebrate at the local level with prizes and displaying of student work.
 - Parish/Schools are encouraged to gain support from parents or local businesses for local prizes
 - Parishes/Schools are encouraged to post local and diocesan winners on their website
- Prizes consist of: 1st Place = \$200.00, 2nd Place = \$100.00, 3rd Place = \$50.00

- September – students learn about Mission of Aloha and create pieces of art; Parish/Schools can invite Fr. Lane, Fr. Herman, or Deacon Keith to speak to your students about this celebration at this time, school chooses diocesan submissions.

MASTER PLAN UPDATE

- CMU wall installation has been completed by Affiliated Construction.
- Structural steel has been installed. Design Build Hawaii, the contractor, is working on the beams for the roofing.
- We have confirmation from Arcadia that fabrication of our storefront doors is underway.
- Stormwater retention & drainage system excavation and connection is complete and backfilled adjacent to the existing church, including the section from front of church to the box drain in North Road.
- HECO has approved switchboard submittal from Roy's Electric & DPP has also given approval of electrical panel installation once the roof of the whole utility room is installed, which has been worked on.
- Monitored security system is being finalized.
- Sauder Worship finalized & executed pricing for furnishing: celebrant chairs, ambry, credence table, etc. These items will ship together with the pews.
- Data Com is being finalized with Comtel & Pacific Direct Connect.
- Church furnishings like: processional crucifix and candles, chalice and ciboria, statues of St. Joseph and Sacred Heart of Jesus, and Gospel Book metal cover, are already delivered.
- Artesanos Don Bosco has shipped to us the altar, ambo, crucifix, stained glass, mosaic for baptismal font flooring, and stations of the cross. These liturgical furnishings are already delivered in campus.
