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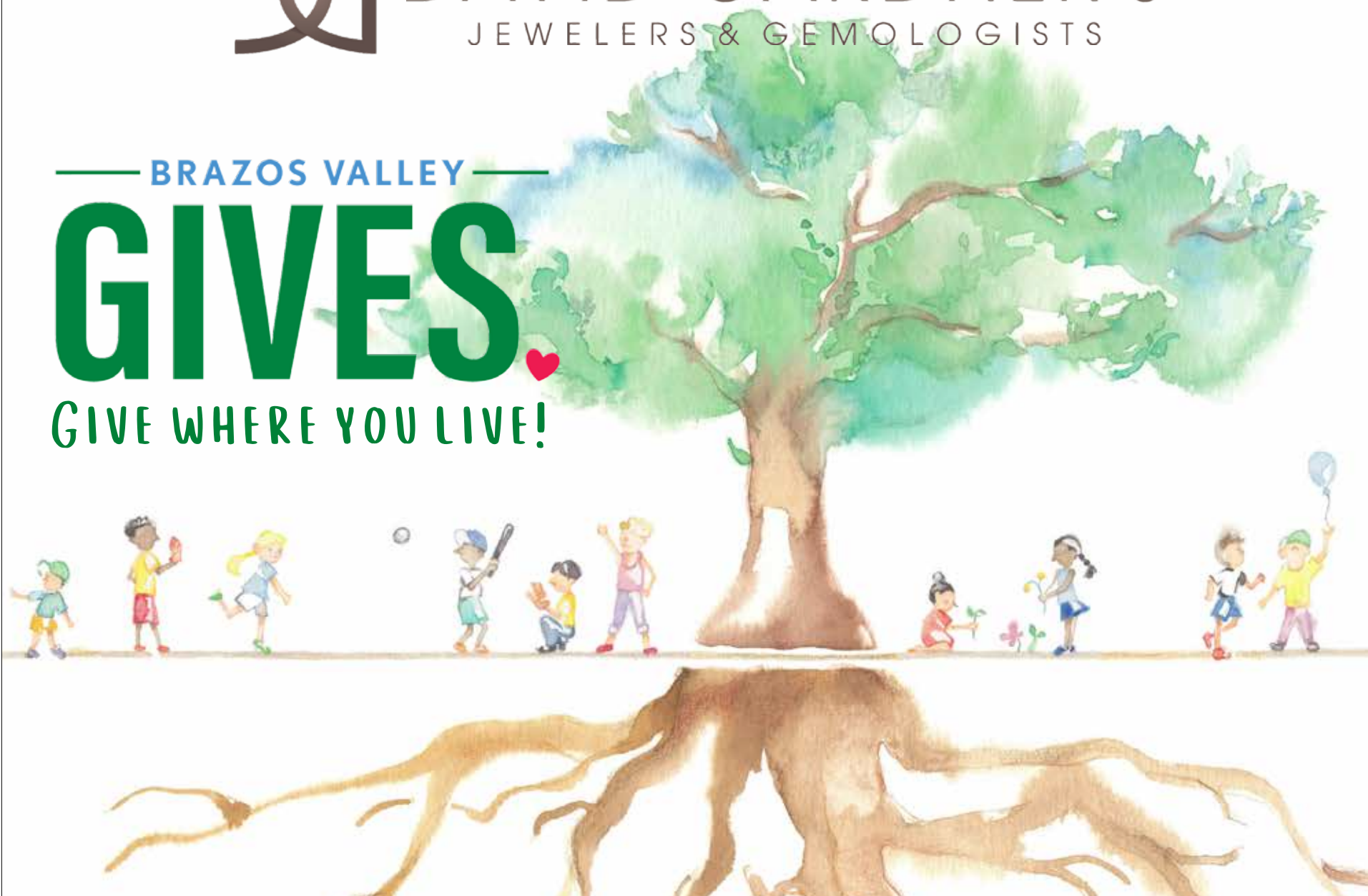

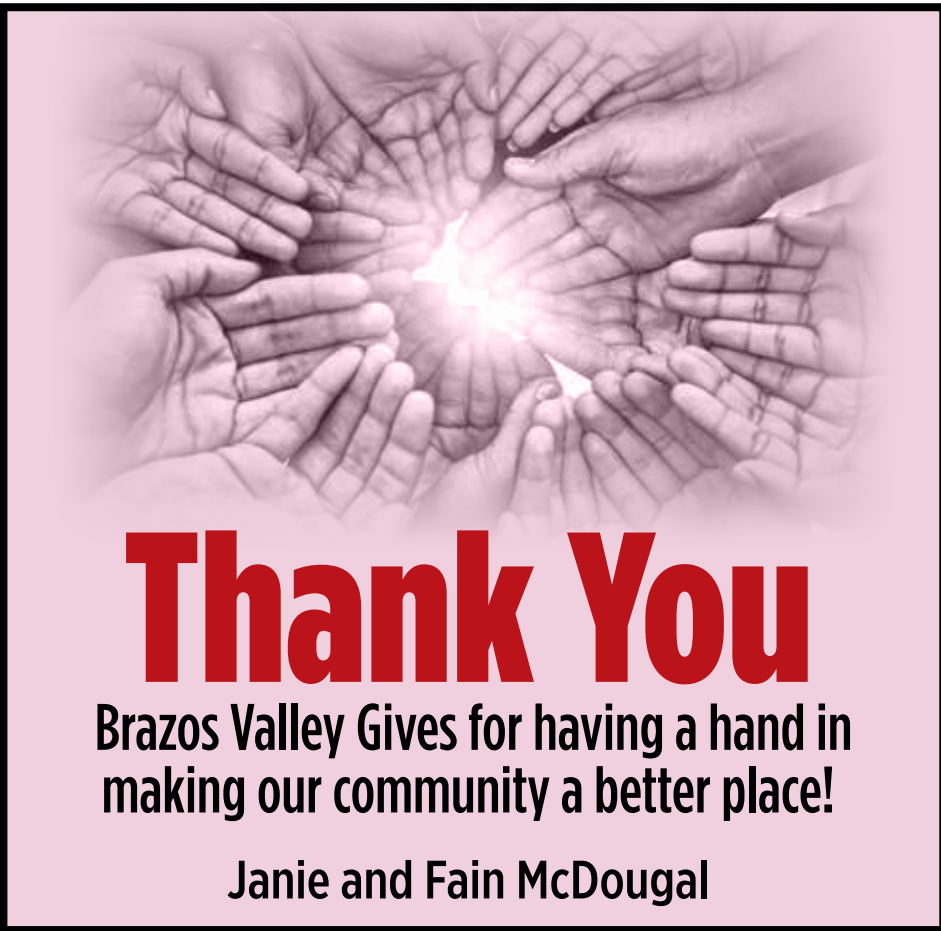

In the Brazos Valley, we have over 1800 nonprofits that provide a way for us to work together for the common good, giving shape to our high ideals and noble causes. Every person in our community benefits from the work of nonprofits in ways that some may not even realize. Nonprofits permeate our daily living and our broader culture—providing important quality of life needs that otherwise would be lost. Nonprofits and philanthropy provide a way to bring communities together—creating equity for all.

Our community is ready for the seventh annual Brazos Valley Gives day. Last year's giving day proved to be one of the most unifying and exciting days of giving for our 7-county region. Our community raised \$1,285,214 dollars that went directly to 198 nonprofits. An additional donation of 977 were pledged. Since its inception in 2019, Brazos Valley Gives has generated \$6,009,522 in gifts to support the work of over 320 participating nonprofits.

So, what is Brazos Valley Gives? Brazos Valley Gives is 18 hours of online giving on the third Tuesday of October, bringing the region together on one day and as one community to raise critical funding and awareness for nonprofit organizations throughout the Brazos Valley. This day of giving provides citizens and businesses an easy platform to support the mission and good works of local nonprofit organizations that serve the Brazos Valley – strengthening nonprofits, empowering donors, and building community.

Championed by the Community Foundation, Brazos Valley Gives also gives businesses an opportunity to be involved in Brazos Valley Gives. Last year, Brazos Valley Gives awarded over \$72,000 in sponsorship prizes to participating nonprofits during a post-celebration event. This year, Keating Auto Group is sponsoring this celebration, which will be held in November at the James A Baker III

Pavillion (formerly the Marine One Pavilion) located adjacent to the Bush Library. Business leaders are empowered to come together to support causes closest to their hearts. Supporting Brazos Valley Gives is a great way to strengthen your corporate social responsibility efforts while engaging your employees and customers in a meaningful way. Local individuals,

can go online to support their favorite nonprofit(s). “We anticipate a record number of nonprofits to participate in the 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. fundraising extravaganza,” said Patricia Gerling, President/CEO of the Community Foundation of the Brazos Valley, the organization that is powering this annual giving day. “These 18 hours of giving will provide all nonprofits with

give to their favorite nonprofit as well as learn about the good works of other charities in our community --- and 100% of the donation goes directly to the nonprofit.

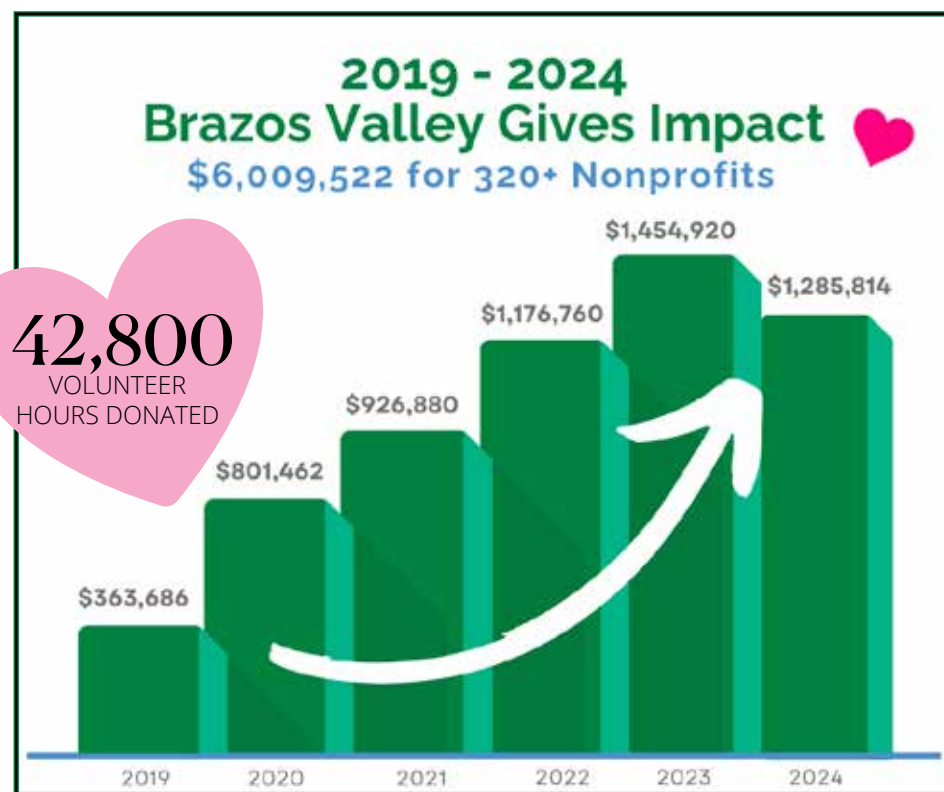
In addition to the online giving platform, the Community Foundation is partnering with Brookshire Brothers in College Station, Brenham and Navasota, as well as The Rodney in Caldwell to offer easy drop-off for donors wishing to drop off a check or monetary donation.

Each participating nonprofit can rally their constituency for a matching gift, which provides an added incentive for donors. Matching gifts also stir the hearts of donors to give, too. If a donor makes a match, the organization will try to raise the same amount from the public during Brazos Valley Gives. Gerling said, “Brazos Valley Gives is our gift to the community.” The Community Foundation does not receive any portion of the donation or transaction fees associated with Brazos Valley Gives. All donations, except for an event/credit card fee, go to the participating organizations. These minimal fees are passed to the donor, or the donor can opt-out.

The Brazos Valley Gives Team set a lofty goal of raising over \$1M for participating nonprofits. Brazos Valley Gives Co-Chair, Molly Watson remarked, “The Brazos

Valley is known for its generosity and support of our nonprofit community. We live here and we want to give here! Last year was an incredible year of giving. We are ready for another banner year. Our hope is that this October 21 online event will once again inspire our community to give and ensure the quality of life needs that are so important to our counties. Everyone has the opportunity to be a philanthropist to build a strong, vibrant community.”

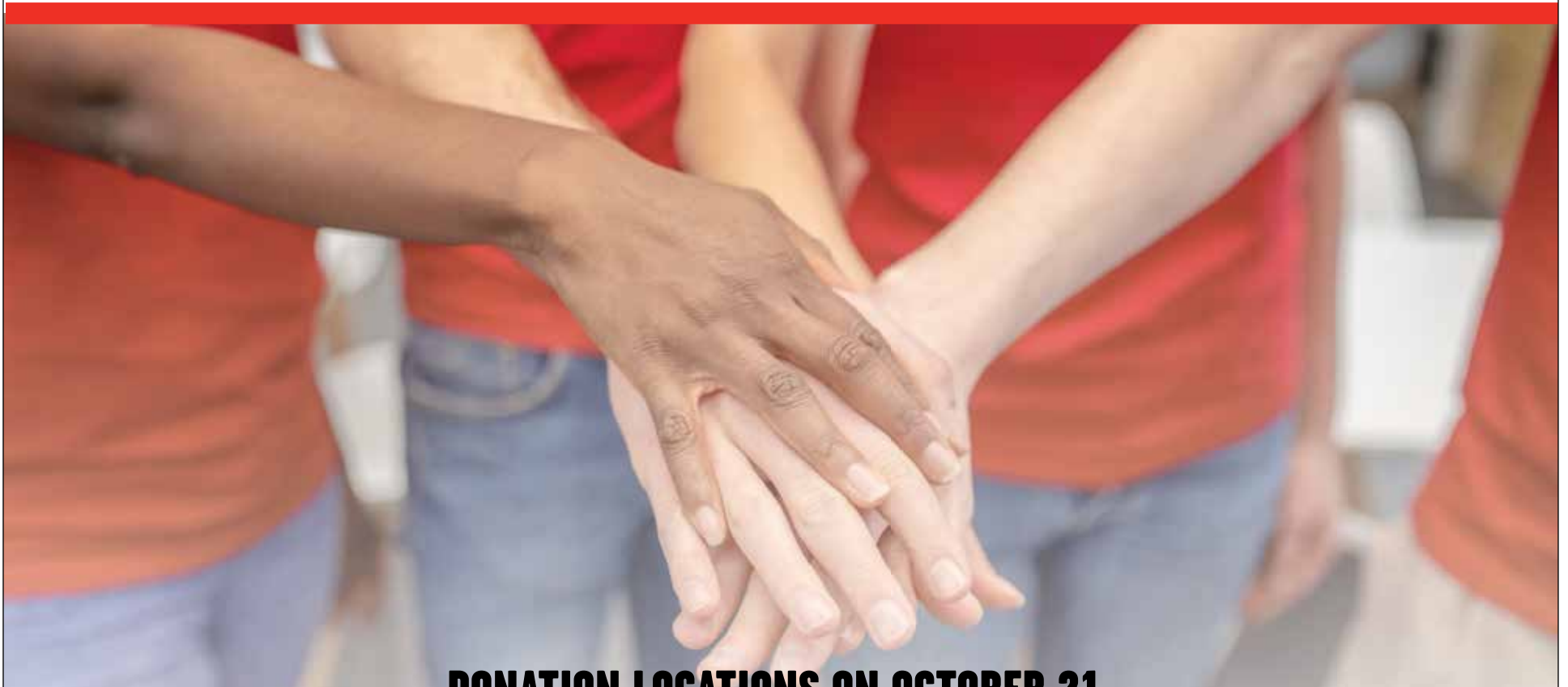

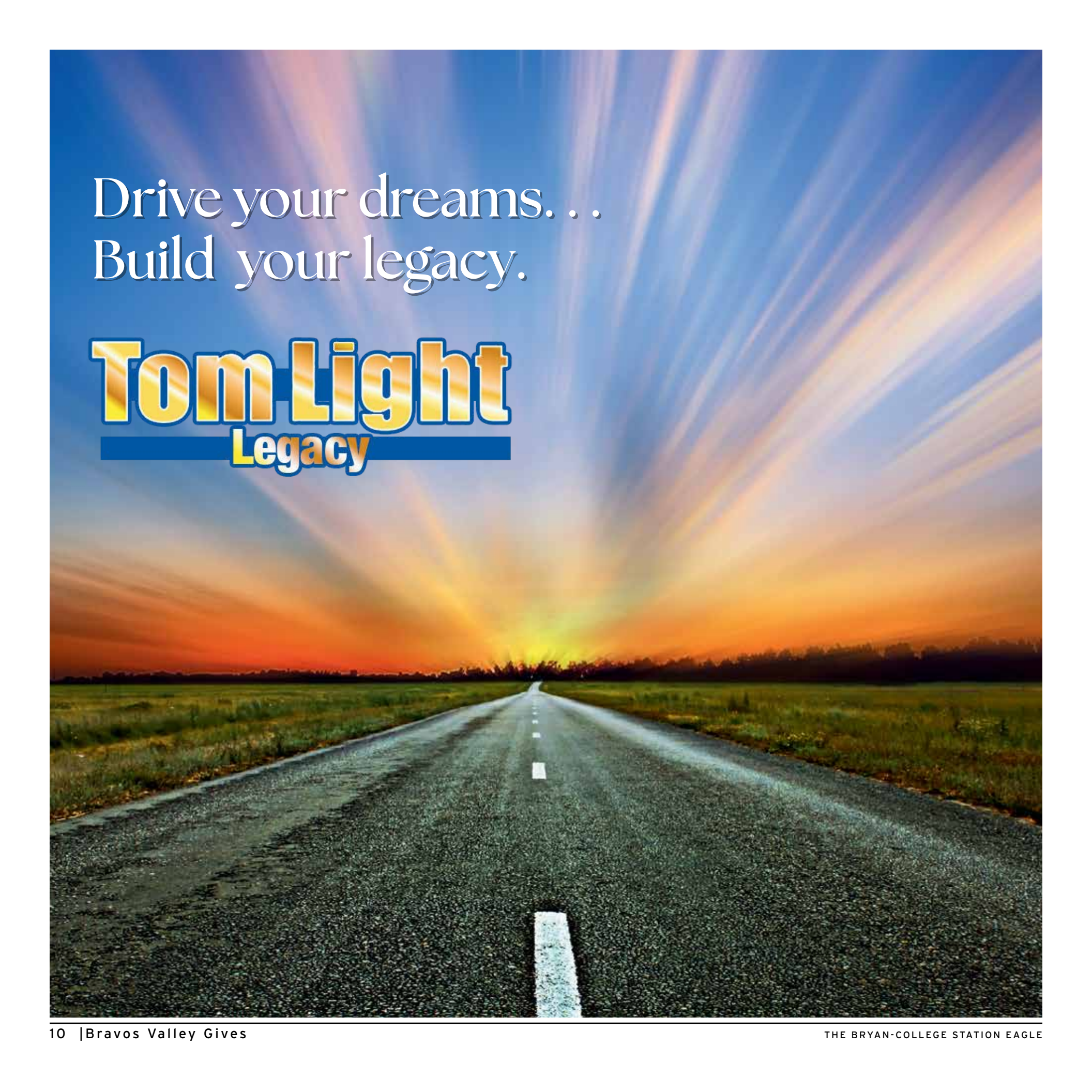

The Community Foundation of the Brazos Valley proudly hosted a heartfelt celebration honoring the incredible impact of Brazos Valley Gives Day 2024. More than 300 nonprofit leaders and community advocates came together to recognize a day that exemplified the spirit of giving and unity across our region.

On Tuesday, October 15, 2024, the 6th

Annual Brazos Valley Gives Day inspired an outpouring of generosity, with donors contributing an astounding \$1,285,814 to support 198 local nonprofits. Thanks to the commitment of our community and sponsors, an additional \$46,500 in incentive prizes and \$8,600 in community grants were awarded, amplifying the reach and impact of these vital organizations.

Looking ahead, we are honored to announce the 2025 Celebration of Philanthropy, scheduled for November 13, 2025, at the James A. Baker III Pavilion (formerly the Marine One Pavilion), adjacent to the George Bush Presidential Library.
