Dear Camper,

We are excited that you are joining us for Family Camp 2026! There are a few things we would like to make you aware of.

- You must be at the camp no later than 6pm on Sunday.
- Family Camp orientation will be taking place at 7:00PM in the LOWER DINING HALL MEETING AREA. **This meeting is mandatory.**

PRICING:

- **Rates include lodging, all camp activities, and meals.**
- **Full Week Pricing:**
 - Ages 8 years and older: \$378 per person for full week
 - Ages 3-7 years old: \$329 per person for full week
 - Ages 2 and under are Free
- **Partial Week Pricing (Any combination of 2 nights and 7meals):**
 - Ages 8 years and older: \$168 per person for full week
 - Ages 3-7 years old: \$123 per person for full week
 - Ages 2 and under are Free

WHAT TO PACK:

- Bedding: sheets, sleeping bag, pillow, etc. (Each room has twin or full size beds with mattresses)
- Fan for your room in the cabins.
- Bath Towels and wash rags
- Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- Snacks for in the cabin.
- Jacket/ sweatshirt for evenings at bonfires
- Bible/ Notebook/Pen
- Bug spray & Sunscreen
- **Beach towel & modest one piece swim suit**
- Money for canteen snacks or Laundry facilities
- **Clothes (Shorts must be closer to the knee than the hip)**
- Raincoat/Poncho/Umbrella
- If you are 16 or older and would like to fish you MUST have a Wisconsin fishing license for the days you would like to fish. You can use this link to purchase a license from the Wisconsin DNR website. <https://dnr.wi.gov/GoWild/nonresident.html> - This is much quicker than going to the Walmart in town.
- **There is a Walmart in town in case you forget to pack anything.**

SOME ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- We will have some limited space on the church trailer for some luggage if you would like to use that. This will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis after the morning service the Sunday we leave.
- **The camp will not be providing bikes for anyone this year. If you would like to have bikes at the camp you must bring your own.**
- The first meal the camp will provide will be breakfast on Monday morning. Everyone is responsible for their own lunch and dinner on Sunday.
- We will have a morning and evening chapel service each day. Morning chapels are at 9:00am and evening chapels are at 7:00pm. Every Chapel service is mandatory to attend.
