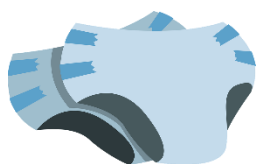

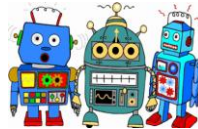

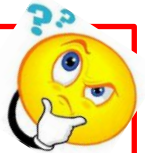
Crystal's Corny Corner
