

# Welcome to Poynton Junior Netball Club

Poynton Netball Club has been established for 49 years. Poynton Juniors was created by our experienced coach Liz in 2020 and currently play on a Saturday at Poynton Leisure Centre. We welcome both boys and girls to the following sessions...

**Session 1: 10:30 -11:45am – School Yrs 3, 4, 5 & 6 (age 6-11yrs)**

**Session 2: 11:50-13:10pm – School Yrs 7, 8, (age 11-13)**

**Session 3: 13:10-14:30 – School Yrs 9, 10, 11 (age 13-16)**

New players wishing to join the club will be offered a trial session on the last Saturday of the month, please contact coach Liz for information about this and to register your child for the trial session.

Monthly subs will be paid by standing order **£20 per month** by the first of each month and will be your responsibility to cancel if the need arises, we will give you the account information once your child has had a successful trial session.

A registration form is available on [www.poyntonnetball.co.uk](http://www.poyntonnetball.co.uk) this will guarantee your child's place alongside the first month's payment, please also have a look at our code of conduct.

You will then be invited to our 'spond app' group which will be used to keep you up to date with all club information, please also accept or decline your attendance to practices on the app, this is important for us to know who is attending as practices are based around the number of players in attendance each week. You will also be added to the correct whatsapp group for your child's age/team. We use both the app and Whatsapp at any time.

**Your child will need to be affiliated to England Netball, information about this will be on the app.**

There will be an opportunity to purchase some kit throughout the year via our online shop, details of this will be sent out when the shop window opens for orders. Training t-shirts are expected to be worn to practice.

When the time allows, we will give your child the opportunity to join the Sunday league (this is charged at £10 extra per month) and hopefully guide your child through the sessions to eventually join our adult club at the age of 15 years.

**Unfortunately, we cannot accept players who are already affiliated with another netball club.**

Please follow our sign in/out guidelines by bringing your child to the main entrance to drop off and sign in, players are then to enter onto the court and start the warm up. Please collect your child from the court entrance and sign out. This is in line with England Netball Safeguarding regulations. The only exception to this if you have given your child permission to arrive/leave on their own (advisable only from groups 2&3) and selected this option on the registration form.

An annual presentation will be organised and information about this will be shared each year. We would love it if you could attend, it is an opportunity for you to show your support.
