

## Dear Friends

I spent last week at Prince of Peace Abbey. An appealing feature of the monastery is the solitude and

the respite from administrative concerns. I used the occasion to remember our parish community and its members in prayer. I had the time to remember those who have died, those who mourn, the health intentions you have shared with me, and the other prayer requests.

Over the twenty years that I have been making retreats there, I have seen changes in the abbey community. Some of the older monks have died. And some who arrived as novices have progressed to final vows and more. During this last visit, I was able to participate in the priestly ordination of one of them. The new bishop of San Diego, Bishop Michael Pham, celebrated the

ordination on July 3 at the monastery. Accustomed to diocesan ordinations, it was the first time I saw Holy Orders administered in a monastic setting.

Father Esteban is a native of Mexico. His family, and many priests and friends, traveled from Mexico for the Mass. Many people in that area of Southern California have roots and family in Mexico. The monks relate that the present environment is creating anxiety and worry for many. Bishop Pham was born in Vietnam. In his homily, he referenced the multi-ethnic composition of the Church in their diocese and throughout the world. The experience has renewed my commitment to pray that Congress and the Administration heed the pleas of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) to work for bipartisan immigration reform legislation.

I had to rush back, of course, for Kids' Camp! We extend our gratitude to everyone who makes this endeavor so much fun. Lastly, we look forward to having Father Patrick with us for the summer.
