



#### A Growing Faith Community

Our parish is only five years old, yet already overflowing with joy and faith. From our small "Mother Church," we serve **13 outstations**—humble chapels made from mud. thatch, and sticks — spread across more than 1,000 square miles. Some are 100 miles away, reached only by motorbike on rough dirt roads.

#### Life in Our Parish

Most of our people are subsistence farmers, earning

less than \$50 a month. Though they cannot give financially, they give generously of their time, coming together every Friday to work on a small parish farm. The harvest from this land supports all our ministries.


Our Mother Church is modest — about 1.200

square feet — with no windows, lighting, or sound **system**. Yet it is alive with prayer, song, and the presence of Christ, and our community grows each week.

#### United in Love, Even When It's Hard

Families long for unity—shared meals, laughter, holiday traditions, attending Mass together, and the comforting rhythm of being present for one another. These moments knit us together, creating bonds that are deep and lifegiving. Nobody enjoys the pain of discord in family life. That's why Jesus' words in this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 12:49-53) can feel unsettling: "I have come to bring division."

At first, it sounds as though Jesus wants to pull families apart. But if we listen closely, His message is not about tearing down love—it's about calling us to a love rooted in truth, courage, and the will of God. Sometimes, that means making choices that are unpopular, even with those closest to us.

Parents know this well. There are times when you must say "no" or set limits, not to divide the family, but to lead your children toward what is right and good. In the moment, these decisions may feel like they create distance. But in the long run, they build a stronger, more united family—one grounded in God's truth.

Our children, too, will face moments when they must choose between fitting in with friends or standing for what is right. This can be hard and lonely. But Jesus promises that His Spirit is with us. The Holy Spirit gives the gift of *fortitude*—courage to do the right thing even when it's not popular.



This week, talk as a family about the choices you each make for the sake of unity and truth. Share how you support one another in those choices, even when they're hard. And then, pray together—asking the Holy Spirit to fill your hearts with courage, wisdom, and love.

May we be families united in Christ, strong enough to choose what is right, and tender enough to love each other through every challenge.




