



Dear Friends,

Happy Labor Day! We extend our prayer-filled best wishes to all who are returning to school. In a special way, we think of those commencing new chapters in their education journeys, such as those beginning High School or College.

While holidays are intended to be times of respite, it is good to recall the nature of this particular holiday. Our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, acknowledges that a reason he chose Leo for his name was his admiration for the last Pope Leo. (Leo XIII 1878 – 1903) Leo XIII did much to promote Catholic Social Teaching. His 1891 landmark encyclical *Rerum Novarum* addressed the rights of workers and called for just remuneration and safe conditions for those who labor. Recently, Deacon Dan gave me a copy. It's been almost thirty years since I last read it as a seminarian. While many of the circumstances confronting workers today have changed, its underlying thesis holds up well 134 years later.


Thank you for the many ways you show the love of Christ through your generosity, compassion, and commitment to helping those in need.

Growing in Grace Giving with Joy: A New Way to Give with ParishSOFT.

Online Giving Change Beginning September 1, 2025

St. Oscar Romero Parish is changing its online giving and registration software to ParishSOFT Managed Giving, which is automatically linked to ParishSOFT, where all parishioner donations are recorded for each parishioner family.

This change signifies a more customer-friendly application for our parishioners and the automation of functions for our administrative support teams. We have researched other applications, what best practices parishes are following, and interviewed other parishes regarding this switch to an upgraded online giving application. We are confident that this choice will result in greater financial transparency, less posting errors, and more accurate reporting.



Additionally, the system is easy to use, provides online giving options, and results in less back-office support.

If you currently have an online giving account with OSV (Our Sunday Visitor), please note that these accounts will automatically close on **September 30, 2025.** If you prefer, you may also choose to close your account before that date.

We are excited to share that parishioners may begin at any time to enroll in ParishSOFT Giving, our new online giving platform. There is no charge to register. When registering, **please include your email address**. There are three easy ways to get started:

- 1. Visit our parish website and follow the link for step-by-step online giving instructions.
- 2. Scan the QR code included in this bulletin and also located on the posters in the entrance of the church.
- 3. Call the ParishSOFT Giving support hotline for personal assistance at (866)-930-4774.



Online giving is easy to do. It encourages all of us to allocate a percentage of our income to the charity of our parish, which is an expression of our gratitude to God for the blessings He has given us. Consistent giving allows us as a parish to better plan and budget. Your generosity helps the church with a predictable and steady cash flow. Your information is always protected as each transaction is secure, and donations are automatically transferred to your parish's account. It also eliminates the need for envelopes and provides various options for second collections as well. You will have direct access to an online annual statement that details your online giving and simplifies your taxes.

Catholic Social Teaching reminds us:


- Work is for the person, not the person for work.




