

Dear Friends,



A cultural phenomenon that insightful social commentators note is too easily overlooked, is the growing cultural, educational and economic division in our communities. These disparities are not new, although they appear to be widening. What is new is the lack of interaction among members of these disparate demographic groups. If we once referred to others as, "Living on the other side of the tracks," it implied living in the same city or town. Students of different cultural and economic backgrounds matriculated at the same schools. They got to know one another through studies, sports and other activities. The trend in recent years has been for the wealthy and the poor to live in increasingly separate, even isolated, environments.

The young men and women of our parish who participate in one or more of our Youth Ministry programs such as Outreach trips, are exposed to life circumstances that they would probably not otherwise observe. One must first notice another's situation before being able to do anything for them.

In today's Gospel, the, "Rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously," was not blind to the suffering of poor, starving Lazarus. His sin was choosing to ignore him. His indifference brought him suffering in the netherworld. This powerful Gospel passage is a cautionary tale. Let us not take our blessings for granted lest we can become indifferent to the plight of others.

Out of care for our parish family and all who visit the cemetery, we want to let you know that one of the underground water pipes has broken. Because the pipe runs close to underground electrical wiring, the repair work is more complex and will take some time.

During this period, a 150-gallon water tank has been placed near the utility shed so that visitors may continue to tend to their loved ones' graves with prayer and devotion. We hope to have the work completed within about two weeks.

Your willingness to serve as ushers, Eucharistic Ministers, readers, adult altar servers, sacristans, and homebound ministers is a gift to our parish. To support you in this important ministry, we will hold a **CORI Weekend on September 27 and 28**.

After every Mass, tables will be set up at the church entrance where you may complete your CORI form, Code of Conduct, and—if needed—sign up for VIRTUS training. Music and Religious Education volunteers will complete their CORI forms at their ministry's first rehearsal or meeting.




